



CoLiberty Service Description

Designed by the public sector for the public sector, CoLiberty is a cloud-based, secure, mobile/tablet-optimised platform which provides Responsible Bodies with a digital toolkit to conduct assessments, administer, collaborate, case manage and report on applications for authorisation under the LPS scheme. The platform facilitates sharing of previous assessments and history between organisations as well as collaborative tools, reducing the effort to produce the assessments required for each request for authorisation. In case of challenge, CoLiberty includes a full audit trail of activities and events on case detail. Everything from initial referral, through assessments, and signoff is reportable.
