We can provide this service where a Virtual Data Protection Officer (vDPO) is required by organisations that do not have a specialist resource internally.



We also offer a service to deal with subject access rights requests, ensuring that internal artefacts are present and updated with changing legislation.

The vDPO can automate and streamline many data protection tasks. The service is not a replacement for a designation DPO when one is required by law, and part of our service is to ensure that they are supported in their role to meet all data protection obligations more efficiently and effectively.
