



- For the Senior Leadership Team (SLT), it provides crucial data and tailored reporting in an easy-to-read format, allowing for timely interventions.
- For administrative staff, the system offers a powerful suite of administration tools that encourage stakeholders to collaborate and improve outcomes
- Assessment leads will be able to set up our secondary tracker in minutes, and access pre-made reports for identifying gaps and planning progress.
- Teachers can take registers, enter assessments, send messages, and log behaviour incidents all from their Class Dashboard.
- Parents and guardians are kept engaged and informed through the MyChildAtSchool app, where they can view school messages, attendance, or behaviour for their child, and make payments for meals, clubs and trips






Reporting




Power BI & Analytics



Curriculum Management

Manage the structure of the school day, academic calendar and the timetable, which covers everything from a morning/afternoon form/tutor group registration to a full subject class-based schedule over a multi week cycle. Timetabling

This module allows you to take your current curriculum model in Bromcom and generate a lesson by lesson timetable for individual teachers. Blocks and carousels can be built and draft timetables can be printed for school staff to review before implementation.

Once your timetable is complete it can be easily imported into the MIS system so that it is ready to go live at the time you choose. Exams


Our built-in exams module makes organising both statutory and internal examinations a breeze. You can import base data from your examination boards and bulk assign these to the students undertaking exams within your school. Data can be exported so that entries with the exams boards can be made. Multiple exam rooms can be managed, and specific exam considerations can also be recorded. This service comes with a price premium to account for the replication of our management services to your private cloud. The private cloud infrastructure can be separately procured from Bromcom or else you as the customer can provide and take responsibility for managing your own suitable private cloud infrastructure, which Bromcom will then use to host your Bromcom services. Bromcom’s Private Cloud option for Cloud MIS and Finance covers the installation of the Bromcom applications and manages Bromcom updates and also deals with the install, configuration and helps manage your SQL database application. A private cloud is listed as an option within our G-Cloud pricelist for those that require this level of control.






Data integrity is key to our business, and we understand how critical data migration is to the successful adoption of Bromcom.

Bromcom migrates a huge amount of data including all staff and pupil data, attendance, behaviour, dinner and for secondaries - exams and timetable. We migrate five years' worth of data as standard with additional years available upon request. Scope documents are available for all migrations, so you can feel confident about what will be included.

Our migrations procedures have been developed over several years and are extremely efficient. It includes SIMS, Arbor and iSAMS migrations taking place at the database level (from a back-up file) using advanced SQL procedures to maximise efficiency and minimise risk. Others such as RM Integris work directly from their cloud service. For those that don't use these systems, we use APIs to retrieve and transform the data remotely or provide a comprehensive set of data exchange files to be used during the data migration from your legacy solution.





Once the contract expires, accounts are decommissioned, and no further access is granted.


