Taking into account populations, sociodemographic, forecasted conditions and other available intelligence data, it supports targeted responses in real time.

Services

| Onboarding

The standard onboarding covers the implementation services, including the cloud hosting configuration, the project management, the contract management, the testing and the activation of the service.

Additional services can be procured using the SFIA rates for customisation, interface development and other support activities.

| Training

The standard training proposed is based on our experience but can be customised with additional consultancy days.

| Licence

Licences are priced on a per user and per annum basis with a difference made between advanced users who have access to all functionalities, whilst basic users are mostly viewers or frontline.

| Support

The licence includes standard support on office hours between 9am and 5pm, Monday to Friday excluding public holiday.

A 24/7/365 support can be costed using the SFIA rates based on specific SLA requirements.

| Hosting

Hosting is priced on a per annum basis. The Solution will be hosted on a PASF-accredited secure AWS environment located in the UK meeting the requirements of availability and resilience expected from a mission critical system, including multi-zone support and secure backups.
