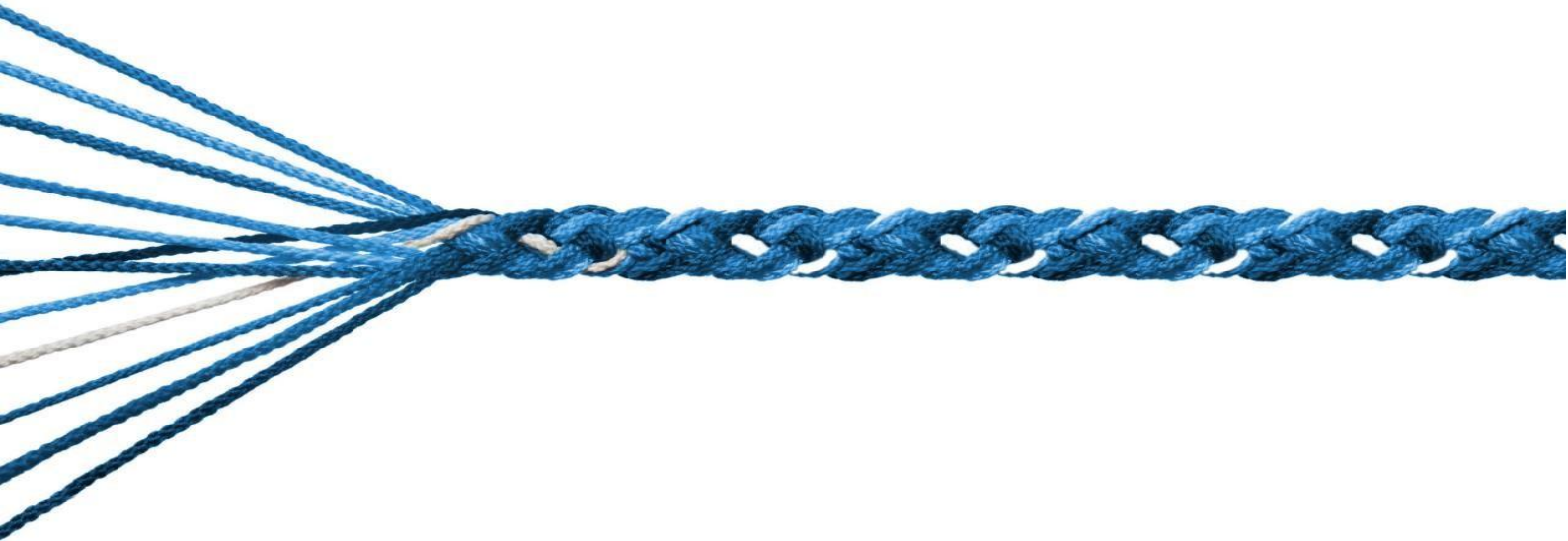

Idox Geospatial Address Query is fully aligned to the government's channel shifting 'digital by default' agenda and the INSPIRE regulations and is backed by enterprise grade service level terms.

Through the intelligent integration of a diverse portfolio of location content, underpinned by the Ordnance Survey data stack, with standard access protocols and delivery standards Idox Geospatial Address Query is proven to simplify what can be complex processes, shorten delivery related activities, smooth location content integration, accelerate usage and adoption of valuable and sophisticated data sets and more easily support location and business intelligence analytics, extracting ever greater value for all types of organisations. With consumption models aligned to usage and a feature rich road map providing insight into greater downstream use of location data, Idox Geospatial Address Query represents an accessible and affordable platform and toolkit for government.

Requests and Transactions

The price of each tier is determined by the volume of queries over a 12 month period.

Service Request Tiers

The volume of Service Requests will fall into one of 4 tiers, these being:

*Usage is equally allocated over each month (1/12th for each month).

We will monitor and report on your Service usage on a regular basis.

If you exceed, or are predicted to exceed, your current Service Usage within the contract term, we will notify you and propose additional charges to accommodate the higher volume of usage.

The minimum contract duration is 12 months, payable annually in advance.

Ordering and Invoicing Process

An order for the Idox Geospatial Address Query service can be initiated from the G-Cloud Catalogue/Cloudstore following Government Procurement Service ordering procedures. However, Idox Geospatial are very willing to discuss any potential use of the service prior to any order being initiated to ensure that the right level of service plan and content are selected. Subject to any such discussion ordering entails agreeing to terms and conditions and determining parameters for API Key.

Invoicing monthly in arrears according to usage.

Termination Terms

Typically 3 months notice is required unless there is a material and persistent breach of any of the obligations agreed under a Call Off or other Contract under the G-Cloud framework or if a change of control of the Supplier causes conflicts of interest or other competition issues.
