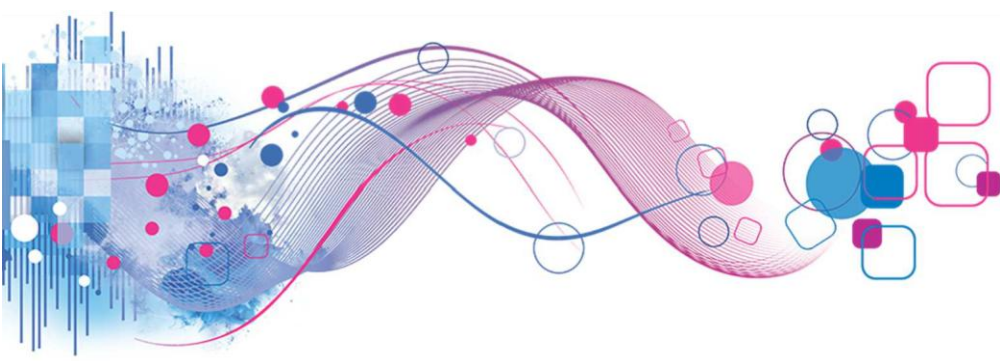

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Pricing for Watchlist Screening

The watchlist screening API is delivered through our CrossCore platform for performing real-time checks against Dow Jones data, providing comprehensive coverage of PEP, Sanction, Watchlist and Special Interest persons and companies.

Pricing is based on tiered annual limits.
