Mobile technology is a key enabler for delivering quality and efficient patient care.

Mobile working is the ability to work from anywhere and at any time, with full access to all necessary documents and clinical data. Printing documents and labels when using a mobile device from any practice location is a critical requirement for mobile working in primary care.

In the primary care environment mobile printing is extremely difficult due to clinical system configuration and the significant variances in software and hardware in use across practices.

There are a wide variety of printer makes and models in every practice and across the national GP IT estate. Absence of standardised printers and label printers is a major challenge to mobile working.

Most GPs do not have fixed consulting rooms, but each GP needs to automatically print to every printer in every clinical room in the practice when using a mobile device.

Clinical Systems: EDGEPRINT supports all primary care clinical systems including EMIS, TPP/SystemOne, and Vision.

Secure: Our mobile print application is hosted in our Microsoft Azure UK Data Centre which hosts the IT infrastructure for our Software as a Service (SaaS) solution. Being Hosted in Azure ensures best practice and offers enhanced Microsoft Cyber security features. It is also fully compliant with Windows 10/11 security features and runs without the need for local admin rights.

Automation and scalability: EDGEPRINT is fully scalable for maximum flexibility. Supports USB, Shared and Networking printing across multiple users cases.

Compatibility: Our Application has been tested as compatible with the most common printers and label printers being used in primary care. Third party label printer software compatibility includes Label Trace and Smart Label.

Installation: EDGEPRINT is simple to install and provides fully managed updates that can be deployed with a variety of On-Premises asset management solutions.

Plug and Play: Plug and Play functionality with pre-set tray configuration and default settings so that the support provider can issue replacement printers without the need for engineering support.

Ease of Deployment: No complex setup on your side and no complex or expensive IT infrastructure required to roll-out a solution.

Reduced Costs: Enables the use of Laptops with docking stations in place of PCs, therefore reducing ongoing out of warranty Dual Capital Replacement Costs.

Our Primary Care Mobile Print Application is a SaaS print solution designed to support NHS healthcare providers to digitise their workforce. Mobile technology is a key enabler for improved quality and more efficient patient care. This hybrid cloud solution is hosted in a Microsoft Azure data centre, which communicates securely with the local client application.

Once the application is installed on a device our software automatically detects which local printers are in use. It then downloads the correct Drivers, Adds Trays, Sets Defaults, Turns off Duplex and makes any additional configurations as necessary. The automation of these processes ensures a seamless transition for users between rooms and provides for a hassle free end user experience. Updates are also pushed out automatically.

EDGEPRINT is a fully managed print application that delivers standardisation and allows for futureproofing of the very complex and disparate IT print infrastructure across primary care and other NHS IT estates.
