

Network Health Check & Assessment Services

Independent assessment of network health, performance and readiness

Network Health Check & Assessment Services provides an independent, structured assessment of existing network environments to give organisations a clear understanding of current health, performance, resilience and readiness for change. The service helps buyers identify risks, inefficiencies and improvement opportunities across wired, wireless and wide-area network infrastructure.

It is designed as a low-risk entry point for buyers seeking assurance, baseline insight or planning support ahead of network refresh, connectivity, security or automation initiatives.

Service Scope

The service provides a focused assessment tailored to the buyer's environment and objectives. Typical activities include:

- Review of existing network architecture and topology
- Assessment of LAN, WAN and wireless configuration and performance
- Review of resilience, availability and fault tolerance
- High-level review of network security controls and access design
- Assessment of operational practices, documentation and visibility
- Identification of risks, constraints and improvement opportunities

The scope is agreed at the outset to ensure minimal disruption to live services.

Key Deliverables

- Network Health Check report with findings and observations
- Baseline snapshot of current network health and capability
- Identification of risks, inefficiencies and technical debt
- Prioritised, practical recommendations for improvement
- Clear next steps to support refresh, connectivity, security or automation programmes
