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1. Overview

VerseOne was founded to use innovative technologies to make a positive difference to people's lives, and this vision is as true today as when the company was founded in 2004.

2. DataSure Data Integrity

Registered Providers of Social Housing (RPs) have started to understand the absolute necessity of good quality data — around their assets and people. The problem has become even more acute with the intervention of the recent legislation and further powers granted to the regulator.

Data cleansing software provides most value when augmented by VerseOne's DataSure — which can consume the generated alerts, and then solicit updates from residents and other stakeholders.

Completing the virtuous circle, with VerseOne's integration capabilities, the correct data can be automatically written back to the Housing Management System (HMS), Asset Management System (AMS), Customer Relationship Manager (CRM), etc.

These innovative technologies remove many barriers to a data cleansing operation, repairing dirty data and maintaining the cleanliness on an on-going basis.

3. VerseOne DataSure Pricing

Working in concert with Data Healthcheck Systems, VerseOne DataSure provides the missing “corrective” element that enables flagged data issues to be swiftly resolved. DataSure is a system that takes inputs, parses them meaningfully, and then generates DataSure Actions.

DataSure leverages the power of VerseOne Autevo to integrate with target line of business systems, enabling clean data to be written back to the appropriate target system. As such, to be most effective, DataSure needs to be combined with Autevo, the pricing of which is included below — but which can be found in more detail in the appropriate G-Cloud service listing.

3.1. DataSure Platform

DataSure requires the base platform to be licensed and integrated with the existing Data Healthcheck system.

3.1. DataSure Usage Credits

In line with VerseOne’s philosophy of ensuring that customers are not paying for what they do not use, there is an element of consumption and usage in the DataSure platform pricing.

Alert Ingestion Tokens	£0.20 – £0.80
Alerts Sent Tokens	£0.40 – £1.20
Actions Resolved Tokens	£0.80 – £1.50

A suggested consumption level is 2,400 of each token per annum (200 alerts per month on average).

3.1. Autevo Platform

In order to undertake an integration project, the VerseOne Autevo platform needs to be licensed and installed.

3.2. Autevo Connectors

For each software system that is integrated, an Autevo Connector needs to be licensed and installed.

Connectors can vary in complexity, depending on the number of Autevo Channels — broadly equivalent to User Tasks — that run through the Connector.

3.3. Autevo Channels

Autevo Channels broadly equate to a User Task or interaction.

Many Channels can be run through a single Connector, but often Channels will require communications through multiple Connectors in order to achieve the User Task.
