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1. Overview

VerseOne was founded to use innovative technologies to make a positive difference to people's lives, and this vision is as true today as when the company was founded in 2004.

2. Accessible Documents Creator

Intuitive, accessible, and mobile-friendly access to information is essential on any website, but is critical for public sector organisations serving a wide range of service users and members of the general public.

Many of these sites are still heavily reliant on use of PDFs (or Word documents) which meet their governance requirements (e.g. for board papers, policies, etc), but which are, by definition, inaccessible.

This is where VerseOne's Accessible Documents Creator (ADC) comes in. Our ADC solution automatically reads PDF and Word documents and converts them to clean, lightweight and accessible HTML pages, including images, all accompanied by our Accessibility Checker. The Accessibility Checker ensures that heading tags, image alt tags, etc, are in place and suggests corrections, in-built navigation indices, links to the original document, and more.

¹ The World Wide Web Consortium that sets the standards for all web technologies, including networking protocols, HTML, Cascading Style Sheets (CSS), and more.

² The technical standards for web accessibility are set by the Web Accessibility Initiative: specifications include Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG 2.0), Authoring Tools Accessibility Guidelines (ATAG) and Accessible Rich Internet Applications (ARIA).

3. ADC Pricing

Accessible Document Creator (ADC) is available as an Enterprise Plus Module for the VerseOne CMS for Intranets, Websites and Portals.

The below pricing is for the stand-alone ADC Solution, which can be set up and managed within a few minutes. All user administration can be delivered through the application itself.

For best engagement, Single Sign-On (SSO) through Active Directory or other Identity Provider is available as an option.

3.1. ADC Platform

The ADC Platform is set up and hosted in VerseOne's Microsoft Azure Managed Cloud Services environment — with all data hosted within the UK. The platform is secured with a TLS encrypted certificate for security of data in transit, and encrypted at rest.

The ADC Platform is set up with 250 document conversion credits: more credits can be purchased, as below..

ADC Conversion Notes

Note that ADC is an automated conversion process and transforming precisely aligned documents into fluid HTML (and associated technologies) cannot provide design fidelity. For this reason, total conversion fidelity, especially for heavily designed documents, cannot be guaranteed (downloads of the original document can be provided as an option by the users).

Accessibility remediation may need to be performed by the user, and ADC provides a set of intuitive tools to address the guidance given by the Accessibility Checker.
