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Price Indexation

The Charges for the SaaS Services shall be subject to annual indexation on each anniversary of the Service Commencement Date.

Any adjustment shall be calculated by reference to the percentage change in the Consumer Prices Index (CPI), All Items (UK), as published by the Office for National Statistics, measured over the 12-month period ending two months prior to the relevant anniversary date.

Any increase shall be capped at 3.5% per annum unless CPI exceeds 3.5% whereby negotiation shall take place. No decrease shall apply where CPI is negative.

The Supplier shall provide the Customer with not less than 30 days' written notice of any indexation adjustment, together with the relevant CPI calculation.

Indexation shall not apply retrospectively and shall only apply to Charges payable after the relevant anniversary date.

Payment Terms

Payment must be made into the riskHive nominated UK account within 30 days of the date of invoice.
