Scope of our Services

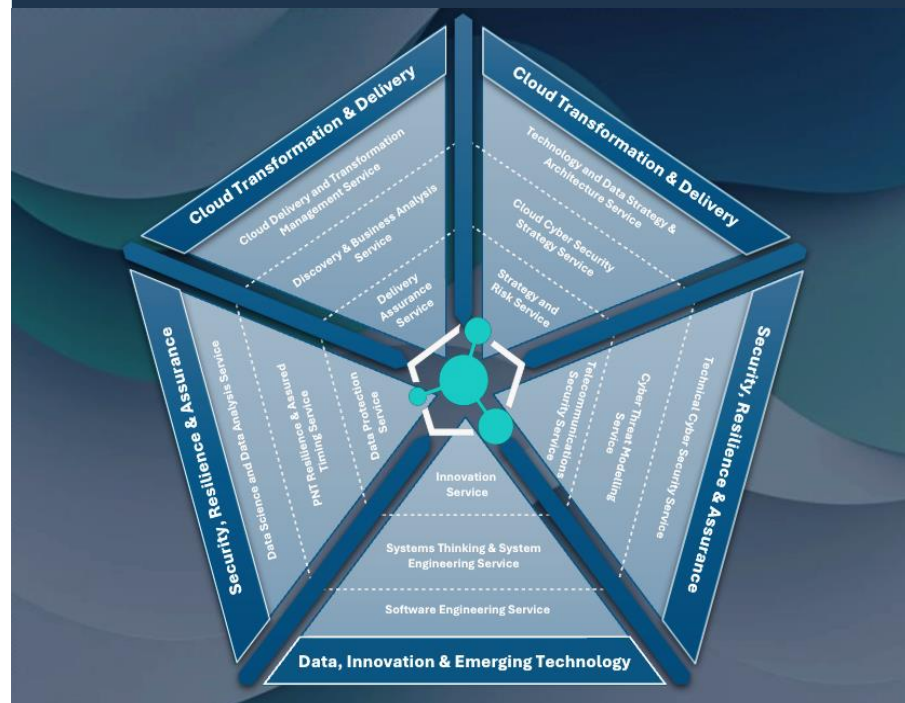
