CyINTER is an AI-enabled cyber resilience management service that helps organisations assess and improve their cyber posture, supporting alignment with UK government standards, including the NCSC Cyber Assessment Framework (CAF).

It translates complex cyber-security requirements into clear, actionable insights, enabling organisations to identify gaps, prioritise remediation activities, and make informed decisions at operational, tactical, and strategic levels.

CyINTER takes each organisation's unique context, risk profile, and operating environment into account, tailoring insights and recommendations to defined roles, responsibilities, and governance structures.

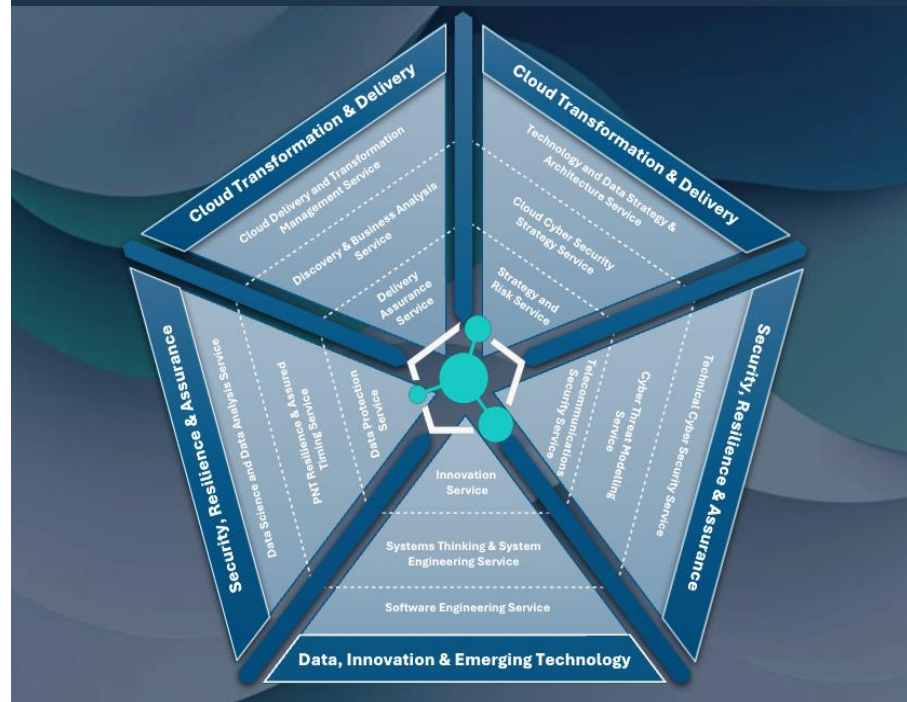
