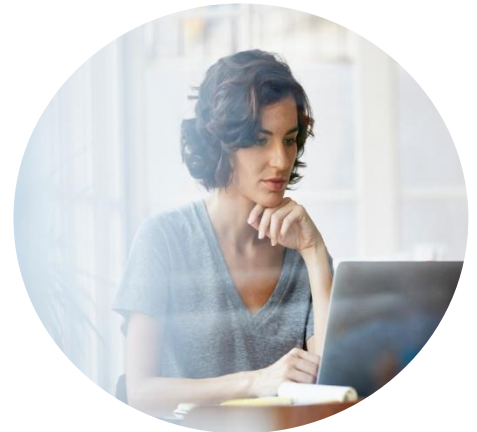

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Overview

TransUnion provides access to UK Electoral Register (ER) data in two formats:

- Full Electoral Register
- Open Electoral Register

These datasets are delivered as batch files for client consumption and can be tailored to cover the entire UK population or specific regions. Data is provided securely via SFTP annually and on a monthly basis if required.

Key Features

- Full ER contains names and addresses of individuals registered to vote
- Full ER is used for limited legal purposes such as crime detection and fraud prevention
- Full ER is commonly accessed by UK police forces for crime prevention and detection
- Open ER is an extract of the electoral register, not used for elections
- Open ER available for purchase by any company, or organisation
- Open ER typically used by businesses and charities to confirm name and address details
- Available as standalone batch output files or via a batch data append service
- Available with full consultancy support

- Supports fraud prevention, identity verification, and compliance checks
- Flexible delivery options for national or regional datasets
