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Overview

eXRt's pricing is designed to support NHS/HSC bodies to deploy at a sufficient scale to gain meaningful benefits in terms of overall cost reductions in providing stroke rehabilitation and care.

There are no transaction charges for the number of data uploads or downloads via our platform, accessed via the VR software or the clinician's web app software and no support charges, maintenance charges or other charges, just one, simple, flat yearly fee. You can upgrade to more user licences at any time for additional costs if you require more patients to use our product.

Usage licenses

Licenses are priced in tiers to accommodate the varying sizes of the NHS hospitals or other organisations purchasing the service. Monthly prices are shown in the table, The table shows pricing per trust, with a minimum contract term is 12 months and a minimum of 40 user licenses.
