Staffology Payroll Billing Explainer

This section sets out how the billing for 'Staffology Payroll' calculates a monthly invoice for a variety of different types of customers.

General Overview

Staffology Payroll uses the total volume of employee's Payslip's ('Payslips') included within an EPS Submissions within the '**Billing Period**', where the value of pay is **greater than £0.00** to calculate the quantity for that respecting '**Billing Period**'.

For the avoidance of doubt, the number of 'Payslips' produced is based upon user activity and will also be dependent on the frequency of pay e.g. Weekly payrolls could have between 4 or 5 '**Payslips**' within a '**Billing Period**' for a single employee.

This quantity is then matched against the assigned 'Contracted Rate' at a 'User' Level to calculate the 'Net Cost' within an Invoice.

e.g., 125 'payslips' would cost as follows:

- 125 payslips x £2.00 = £250.00
- **Total Net Cost: £250.00**

Glossary of Terms

- **Billing Period:** Billing process is completed on the first couple of working days of a new month, for the prior monthly consumption.

Example: The December 2026 invoice will cover the billing period between the 1st of December 2026 to 31st December 2026 and will be issued on either the 2nd or 3rd of January 2027.

- **Payslips:** For the purposes of billing quantities, a Payslips is where an employee is submitted on an Employer Payment Summary (EPS) with a payment value of greater than £0.00 via RTI to the HMRC. The quantity is based upon the timestamp of that EPS submission and doesn't relate to the pay date of the employees payrun.
- **Previously Billed:** This stops a customer being duplicate billed for the same Payslip within the same pay period, when the users has re-submitted the EPS via RTI to the HMRC.
