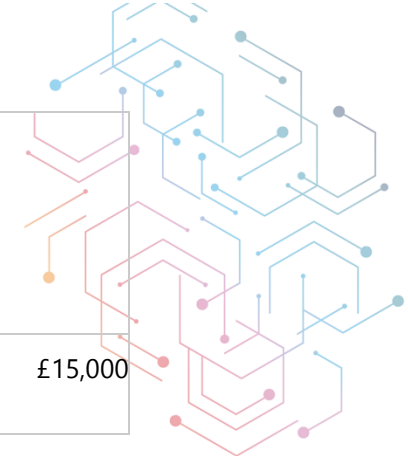

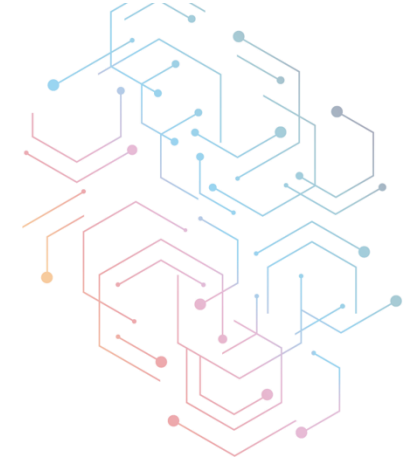
4. Notes

¹ The above costs are the unit rates only and not the total cost for each service line (although the minimum number of days has been provided for reference purposes).
