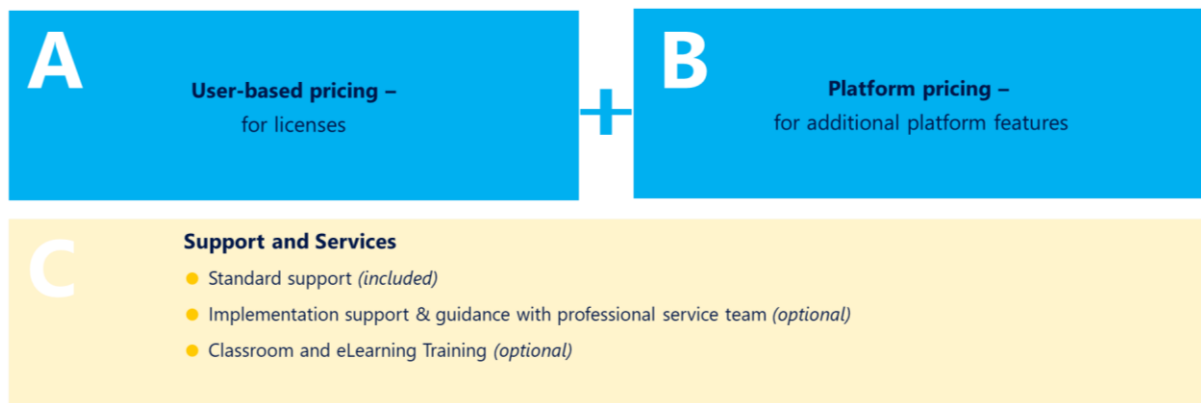
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1. Introduction

1.1. Pricing Approach



Horizon pricing is based upon named user licenses + a platform license fee.

A: User Packs

We offer three user license types (described in Section 2.1):

- Pro-EA (also known as Designer)
- Contribute
- View (also known as Consume)

We offer User Packs, reflecting different mixes/volumes of the above license types. Multiple User Packs can be purchased.

Select the appropriate user pack from Section 2.

B: Platform Packs

Platform pricing is tiered based upon any additional platform features the Buyer requires (described in Section 3.1).

We offer Platform Packs, with different blends of platform features. Select the appropriate platform pack from Section 3.

C: Support and Services

Standard support is included.

Optional services (support and training) are also available.

Select the appropriate Services from Section 4.

Overall price

2.1. User License Types

The following table summarises the platform features available to each user role, mapped to the license types described above.

Role [License]	Key permissions
Consumer [View]	Horizon – Access to sites. Inspect and explore views, objects and relations in a site. Store favourites and perform self-service data visualization, analytics and reporting. Access to dashboards.
Contributor [Contribute] *	Horizon – All Consumer permissions, plus share views and create posters. Start workflows and perform workflow tasks. Edit data directly in Horizon sites and perform data stewardship tasks.
Designer [Pro - EA User] **	Horizon – All Consumer permissions, plus share views and create posters. Start workflows and perform workflow tasks. Manage user and group access to their model packages and projects and set access permissions. Enterprise Studio – Work and collaborate on all model packages (if invited) including all notations. Create custom workflows and create and upload data block definitions.
Lead Designer [Pro - EA User] **	Horizon – All Designer permissions, plus create and edit sites, embed views, manage (edit and delete) workflows, create and share dashboards. Set up data policies and data maintenance for data blocks. Enterprise Studio – All Designer permissions, plus create model packages and projects and save them on Horizon, restore model packages and projects to a previous state. Open and edit metamodels in the Meta-modeller. Migrate model packages to a new configuration. Upload custom workflows (definitions) to Horizon.
Administrator	Horizon – View and manage all users, groups, model packages and projects available in Horizon. Manage all users and groups, remove claims on model packages of any user. View license settings, add API clients, manage (edit and delete) workflows, terminate all workflow requests. End other users' Enterprise Studio Online session.

* A [Contributor] role includes access to [Consumer] features.

** Any [Designer] role includes access to [Contributor] and [Consumer] features.
