

Government End User License Agreement (EULA)

Software: Platform and related components ("Software")

Licensee: The Government Agency or Authorized Contractor ("Licensee")

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Licensor grants the Licensee a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable, and revocable license to install, access, and use the Software solely for authorized government purposes, in accordance with this Agreement and applicable procurement regulations. Use of the Software is restricted to government-authorized personnel and systems.

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The Licensee agrees to handle all Software, associated data, and documentation in compliance with applicable government security requirements, including but not limited to FIPS 140-2, FedRAMP, and agency-specific information assurance policies.

7. Confidentiality

Both parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of proprietary and sensitive information disclosed during the term of this Agreement, consistent with applicable government and contractor confidentiality laws and regulations.

8. Term and Termination

This Agreement remains in effect until terminated. Either party may terminate this Agreement upon written notice if the other party materially breaches any term and fails to cure such breach within thirty (30) days. Upon termination, the Licensee must cease use of the Software and destroy all copies.
