1. Free Credits (Get Started)

- New users receive \$50 of free credits with no upfront commitment.
 - Credits can be used across all Corti APIs and capabilities for development, testing, and production.
 - Credits are valid for one year from purchase. ([corti.ai](https://www.corti.ai))
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2. Usage-Based Pricing

- The platform uses a pay-as-you-use billing model measured in credits.
 - Audio-based requests consume credits per minute.
 - Text generation consumes credits based on input and output tokens.
 - Credits are shared across all workflows; developers can shift usage freely. ([corti.ai](https://www.corti.ai))
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3. Acceleration Packs (Optional Add-Ons)

For teams that want hands-on help building and scaling:

 - 5 hours per month of developer experience support

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4. Enterprise Deployments (Custom Pricing)

Customised plans for large-scale or regulated use:

- Predictable credit bundles
 - Higher concurrency and throughput limits
 - Priority support, custom-trained models, and advanced features
 - Secure or sovereign cloud deployments for compliance needs
 - Deployment, pricing, and terms are tailored based on organisation requirements. (corti.ai)
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5. Credit Management and Usage Tracking

- Credits can be used across all API endpoints without restrictions by feature.
 - Usage is monitored via the Corti AI Studio dashboard, showing consumption by project and API key.
 - There is no mandatory minimum spend required to get started. (corti.ai)
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6. How Credits Work (Context)

- Credits reflect actual platform usage based on endpoints called, request size, and workflow complexity.
 - Examples include workflows such as Ambient Scribe, Dictation Assistant, and Pre-Charting Summarization that consume credits based on use. (corti.ai)
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
