Core Challenges



Organisations are attempting to Implement data governance policies but knowledge and skillsets around the topic are limited at senior levels.

Reduced capacity to adopt new technologies/programmes (e.g. AI adoption) due to fundamental governance strategies not being in place.



Unable to secure backing/buy-in for their data strategy due to role ownership and delivery pathway not being agreed on.
