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1. What is Data Platform Implementation?

Microsoft Azure

Atos enables customers to realise modern data platforms on Azure by leveraging services such as Azure Data Factory, Azure Data Lake Storage Gen2, Azure Synapse Analytics, Azure Databricks, and Microsoft Purview, supporting scalable analytics, governance, and enterprise security.

Amazon Web Services (AWS)

Atos supports customers in adopting modern data capabilities on AWS using Amazon S3, AWS Glue, Amazon Redshift, Amazon EMR, MSK (Kafka), and Lake Formation, enabling large-scale data processing, real-time ingestion, and governed analytics.

Google Cloud Platform (GCP)

Atos helps customers leverage cloud-native data capabilities on GCP using BigQuery, Cloud Storage, Dataflow, Dataproc, Pub/Sub, and Vertex AI, enabling high-performance analytics, real-time data processing, and AI-driven insights.

Databricks

Atos enables customers to leverage the Databricks Lakehouse Platform with Apache Spark, Delta Lake, and MLflow to unify data engineering, analytics, and AI/ML workloads, accelerating insight generation and advanced analytics use cases.

Snowflake

5. Termination

Termination shall be in accordance with:

- The G-Cloud Framework terms and conditions
- Any terms agreed within the Call-Off Contract under Part A Order Form (Termination), where the Crown Commercial Service guidance states: 'The notice period needed for Termination is at least 30 days from the date of written notice for termination without cause'
- Atos Supplier Terms for this Service are as listed on the Digital Marketplace
- For this specific service, by default Atos ask for at least thirty (30) days prior written notice of termination without cause.

Atos commits to continue to provide the service for the duration of the Call-Off Contract subject to the terms and conditions of the G-Cloud Framework Agreement, the Call-Off Contract, the Atos Supplier Terms and the applicable Third-Party Agreements (as defined in the Atos Supplier Terms) related thereto.
