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1. What is Responsible AI by design?

Overview

Responsible AI by Design is a service that supports organisations in designing and deploying AI in a way that meets ethical standards and regulatory expectations. It focuses on ensuring that appropriate controls are built into the development, governance, and use of AI solutions.

The service integrates ethical considerations, risk management, and compliance activities into the AI lifecycle. This helps organisations adopt AI while maintaining appropriate oversight and accountability. It is particularly relevant when AI governance is fragmented, responsibilities are unclear, or the visibility of models and training data is limited, especially amid increasing regulatory scrutiny.

A responsible approach to AI helps organisations realise value from AI while maintaining confidence in its use. Transparent governance and oversight improve trust in AI outputs and support consistent adoption across the organisation.

Responsible AI practices also reduce exposure to regulatory and reputational risk associated with poorly governed or biased systems. By improving transparency and monitoring, organisations are better positioned to ensure that AI solutions remain aligned with business objectives over time.

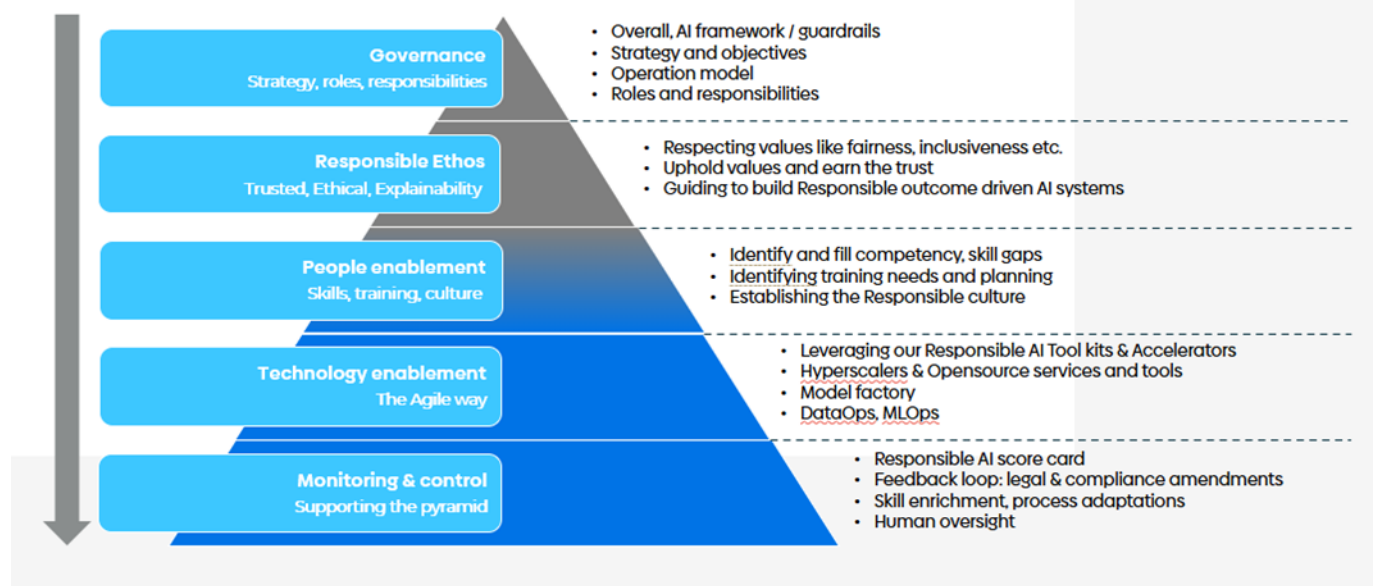

Atos Responsible AI Framework Implementing Responsible AI - by Design

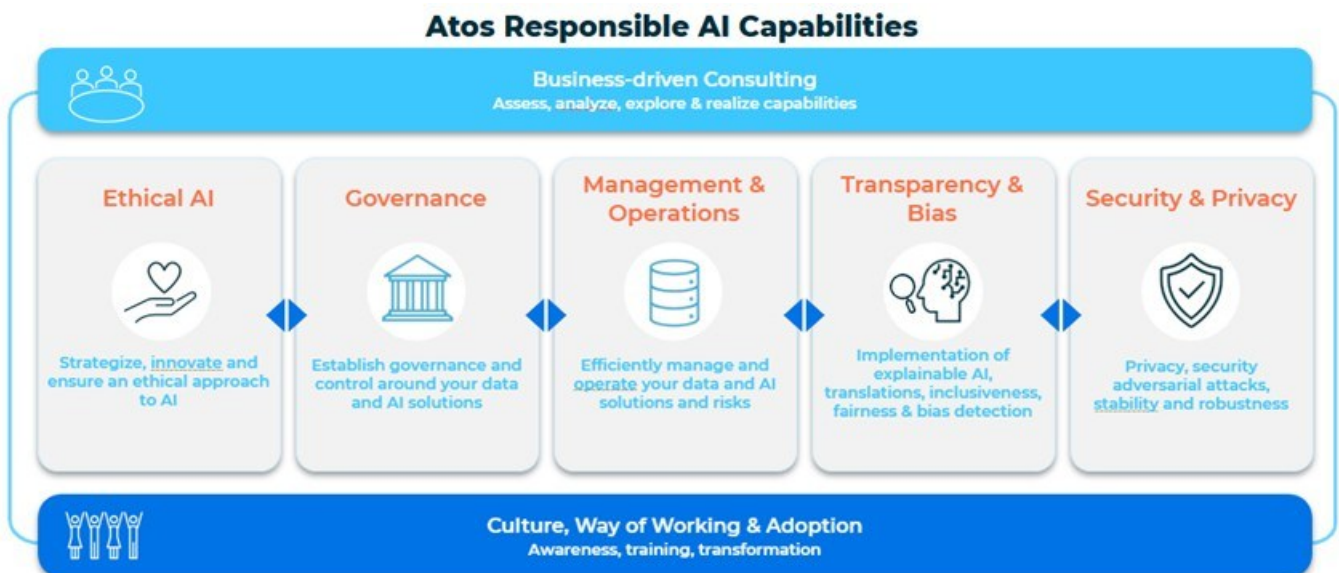


Responsible AI capabilities

These capabilities are supported by business-driven consulting and a focus on culture, ways of working, and adoption.





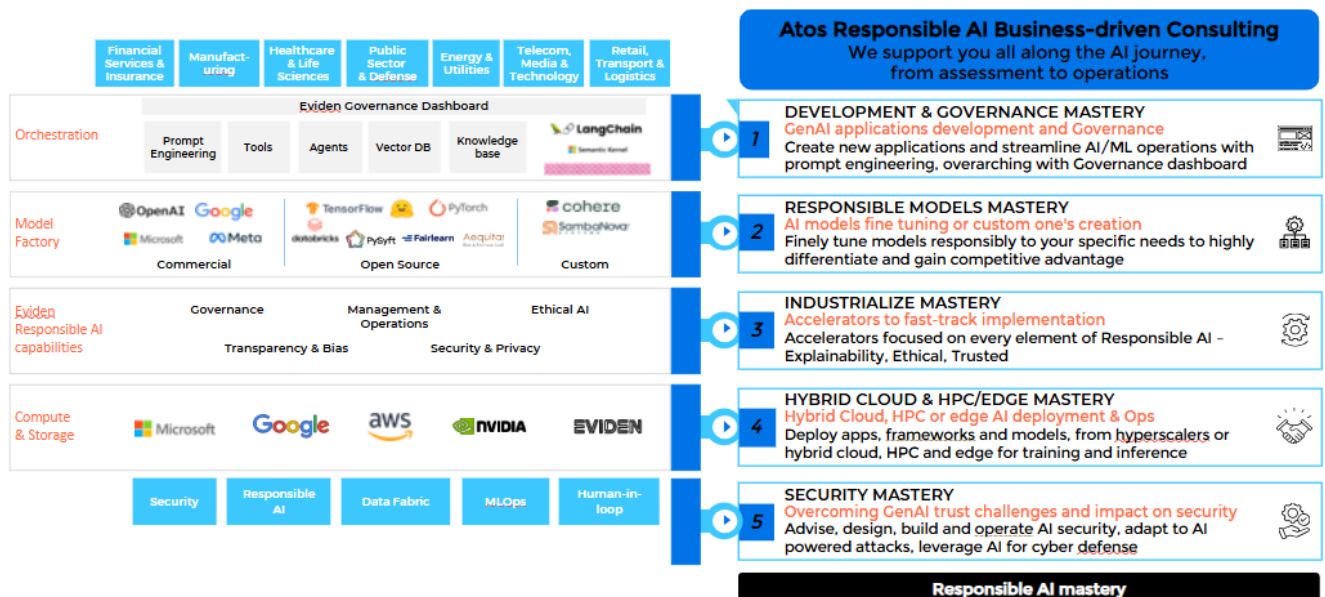
3. What technology does it use?

Responsible AI by Design uses enterprise AI platforms, cloud services, and governance tooling to support the responsible development and operation of AI systems. The service is technology-agnostic and designed to work with platforms already in use across the organisation.

The supporting technology covers the whole AI lifecycle, including model development, deployment, monitoring, and oversight. Governance tooling provides visibility and control over AI systems, enabling transparency, explainability, bias management, and lifecycle tracking.

Security and privacy controls are applied across the platforms used, aligning with existing cybersecurity and data protection practices. Monitoring and reporting capabilities support ongoing oversight and informed decision-making, ensuring AI systems remain compliant and trustworthy over time.
