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1. What is Oracle PaaS Migration and Integration Services?

Many government organisations have requirements unique to their functions and want to enhance the Oracle Fusion Cloud application to meet the needs of their end users. Also, organisations want effective and efficient methods of migrating their business data in and out of their Oracle Fusion Cloud applications.

Atos offers a range of Oracle PaaS Cloud services to provide application enhancements integrated with Oracle Fusion Cloud applications, to simplify the integration of cloud-based systems, automate the flow of application data into Oracle Fusion applications, and facilitate the migration of data from Oracle E-Business Suite applications into Oracle Fusion Cloud applications.

Over the past few years, many government customers have migrated to Oracle Fusion Cloud applications and have found that a different approach is needed for application enhancements and data integration. 2. What does it deliver?

AtoS offers a range of Oracle PaaS Cloud Services and tools that encompass the following key areas:

- Integration using Oracle Integration Cloud (OIC): It simplifies the design of integrations. OIC provides pre-built connectors for both technologies (e.g., database /file) and applications (e.g., E-Business Suite, Fusion Applications). Integrations are designed declaratively and enable data mapping and transformations. OIC includes the ability to orchestrate web services and to build user interfaces rapidly with the introduction of the visual builder
- Using ATP database: AtoS' integration controller is a light-weight application based on APEX, PL/SQL and REST APIs, which automates the flow of application data into Fusion applications. The service translates and integrates data between Cloud and legacy solutions at a low cost of ownership, delivered on a SaaS model
- Data Migration: AtoS offers a set of pre-built transformation and mapping processes for migrating E-Business Suite Financial and HCM business data to Fusion applications. Using these processes will greatly decrease the complexity and timescales required for data migration
- Designing and developing low-code applications in Oracle PaaS using tools such as Oracle APEX and VBCS
- Integrating the applications with Oracle Fusion Cloud Applications using Oracle Integration Cloud (OIC) or FBDI for financial forecasts to provide automated uploads/downloads
- Workflow solutions designed and built to orchestrate web services using Oracle Process Cloud Service (PCS).

Features of the service include:

- Assisting in data mapping/integration design when standing up a new service
- Defining strategy for PaaS, business cases, roadmaps and project planning
- Defining Solution and Technical Architectures for new Oracle-based cloud products and processes
- Design and implementation of security for Oracle PaaS solutions
- Augmenting existing technical resources.

Benefits of the service include:

- Cloud implementation lifecycles are shortened by using pre-built connectors to quickly integrate cloud-based systems, making deployment much quicker than traditional on-premises projects
- Cloud fusion middleware services can be rapidly deployed to orchestrate and manage an organisation's integrations with a heterogeneous set of applications. Cloud-based platforms can be used to store, transform, cleanse, validate and enrich source business data in preparation for loading into target applications.

3. What technology does it use?

When deploying cloud-based solutions, it is essential to avoid the creation of silos of data, contained within individual business applications that are unable to communicate with each other. As efficient business processes typically span multiple applications, the inability to integrate and interface can be a significant barrier to the success of Cloud projects.

Oracle Cloud Infrastructure offers Cloud Fusion Middleware services that can be rapidly deployed to orchestrate an organisation's integrations with a heterogeneous set of operational applications, including SaaS and on-premises applications.

This ensures that customer organisations benefit from the use of SaaS, and it is where Atos adds value. Atos can take the customer on a journey to SaaS, using PaaS as an integration platform to ensure a safe, rapid, and efficient implementation.
