IBM Cloud sometimes makes changes to offerings, included but not limited to: changing offering names, adding new offerings, removing existing offerings, adding or removing offering capabilities, changing costs per unit, changing units used to measure cost.

There are the following billing options:

- **Pay-As-You-Go:** charged based on your use of provisioned Cloud compute and services
- **Subscription:** discounts are available based on a minimum monthly spending commitment and length of contract

1.4 Unit Based Pricing

You are billed for the memory and vCPU that your workloads consume, as well as any incoming HTTP calls. If your app scales to zero or your job or build isn't running, you are not consuming resources and so you are not charged.

Application pricing

When you deploy an application, charges apply for HTTP requests and for the CPU and memory resources that are consumed by running instances of the application. Incoming HTTP calls are billed by the number of HTTP calls that are received by your application. For example, if your app serves 100 calls, you are then billed for 100 HTTP calls. Internal HTTP traffic within a project between your workloads is excluded from the billable HTTP call total.

Job pricing

When you run a job, charges apply for the CPU and memory resources that are consumed by the job when it runs. You are not charged for your job configuration.

Function pricing

When you deploy a function, charges apply for HTTP requests, and for the CPU and memory resources that are consumed by running instances of the function. Incoming HTTP calls are billed by the number of HTTP calls that are received by your function.

Available subject to sizing and Statement of Work.

1.6 Resourced Based Pricing

Separate pricing will be available for operational resource, depending upon requirements.

IBM will convert the U.S. Dollars charges using an exchange rate as required by law or based upon a Bloomberg daily spot rate on the business day prior to the date IBM prepares your bill in your local currency.

The exchange rate used to calculate your monthly bill may differ over time. If the exchange rate fluctuates this will affect the £UKP price shown. The representative local currency amounts shown here were calculated using an exchange rate of **£GBP 0.7865 / \$USD**.

There may be additional charges for connectivity (PSN, ALI/RLI), Data Halls and Accreditation. Any such pricing for these dependent activities will be detailed during the initial project design phase.
