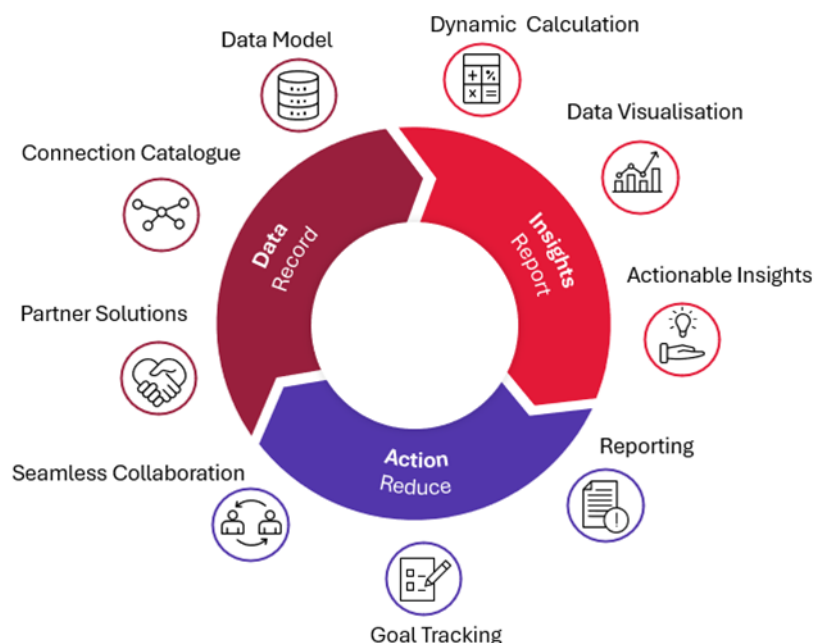


Figure 1 - Driving actionable insights from ESG data

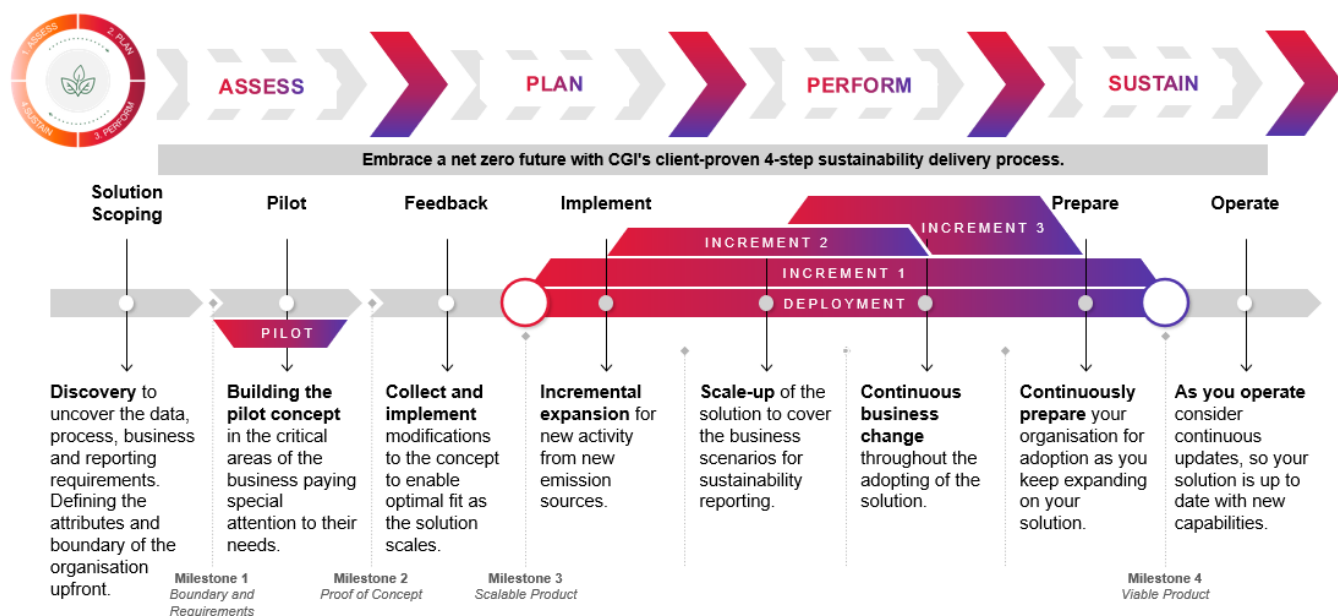


Figure 2 Integrating best practices into our approach
