1.2. CGI Pricing

- Campus WAN or inter-site circuits – pricing depends on circuit types, bandwidth, and regional carrier availability.
- Professional services for design and deployment – priced separately based on the scope and complexity of each engagement.
- On-site support for hardware replacement or intervention – not included as standard; this is dependent on client requirements and may be delivered via separate engagement or customer resources.
