

OKA Pricing Document

OKA is priced per **instance** and per **cluster**.

- An **instance** of OKA is defined as one installation of OKA on a single physical or virtual server.
- A **cluster** is defined as one instance of job scheduler.

The **primary cluster** is the largest on-premises cluster, in terms of number of CPU cores.

Other on-premises clusters are called **additional clusters**.

An **OKA Core** license is required for on-premises clusters, while an **OKA Cloud** license is required for cloud clusters. The **License Analysis Module (LAM)** is an extension for both products to analyse software license usage data from the job scheduler.
