WHY COSHH & SDS MANAGEMENT MATTERS

Hazardous substances are part of everyday work – but unmanaged, they can cause serious harm. Employers must understand the risks from chemicals and other hazardous substances, control exposure and ensure employees know how to work with them safely.

Spreadsheets, paper files and scattered SDSs make it difficult to see what substances you have, where they are used and whether assessments and controls are still current.

With AssessNET, you can build a single view of the substances you use, link the latest SDSs, create suitable and sufficient CoSHH assessments and make sure employees can easily access the information they need.

KEY FUNCTIONS

Build a live inventory of hazardous substances

Create and maintain a central list of the substances used across your sites. Record where they are stored and used, who is exposed and what they are used for, so you have a clear picture of chemical risk.

Manage Safety Data Sheets in one place

Store SDSs against each substance so the latest version is easy to find. Replace out-of-date documents and link SDS information directly to your CoSHH assessments.

Create clear, consistent CoSHH assessments

Use structured templates to record hazards, exposure scenarios, control measures and emergency arrangements. Apply a consistent approach to judging risk and documenting how exposure is controlled.

Use CoSHH AI to speed up assessments

Support your team with AI-assisted CoSHH assessments that read SDSs and help you populate key information. Reduce manual effort while keeping full control over the final content.

Keep employees informed and involved

Share CoSHH assessments and key safety information with employees through an intuitive portal, so they can see the risks that apply to them and the controls they must follow.
