WHY FIRE SAFETY MATTERS

A fire risk assessment is a legal requirement and a vital safeguard. Every workplace must understand its fire hazards, who could be harmed and how effectively current measures control the risk.

Paper-based assessments and scattered action logs make it difficult to keep assessments up to date, prove what has been checked or show that recommended actions have been completed.

With AssessNET, you can standardise your fire risk assessments, record significant findings clearly and keep a live view of fire-related actions and residual risk across your estate.

KEY FUNCTIONS

Create structured fire risk assessments

Use configurable templates to record key information about premises, activities and occupants. Capture fire hazards, existing controls, people at risk and significant findings in a clear, consistent format.

Evaluate likelihood, consequence and overall risk

Apply a standard risk matrix to evaluate fire risk before and after controls. Use the resulting ratings to prioritise improvements and focus resources on higher-risk areas.

Record significant findings and recommendations

Document where controls are adequate and where improvements are required – from housekeeping and compartmentation to detection, warning and means of escape. Add notes, photos and supporting evidence to each finding.

Create and manage corrective actions

Raise actions directly from assessment findings, assign owners and target dates, and monitor progress through to close-out. Escalate overdue actions so critical fire safety improvements are not missed.

Plan reviews and re-assessments

Set review dates for each premises, and trigger re-assessment when things change – such as layout alterations, occupancy changes, incidents or new activities.
