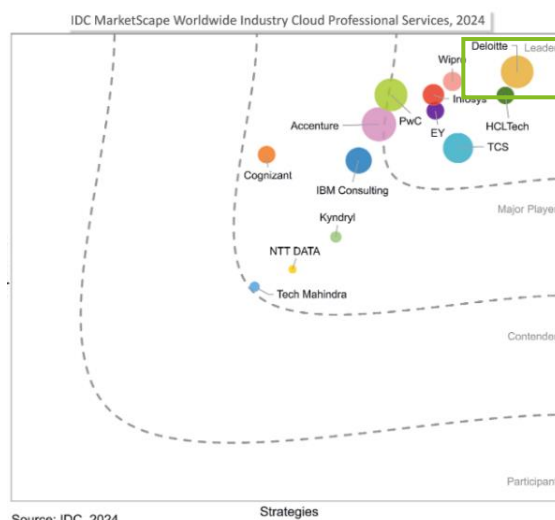

Strategy and Advisory

We will support your organisation by working in collaboration with your project team and wider stakeholders to define the nature of the services required and set up the project to succeed. This typically includes:

- Discovery exercises to understand your challenges and objectives.
- Building your strategic vision, case for change and implementation roadmap to support it.
- Performing a maturity assessment with recommendations.
- Building 'art of the possible' demonstrations and rapid prototypes using the chosen Platform.
- Creating a project plan for future development activities where required.

Business Analysis and Requirements Gathering

We will work with you to fully understand your technology landscape, key processes and pain points, before compiling your requirements and proposed design, aligned to your business objectives. This typically includes:

- Performing an 'as-is' analysis and proposing a high level 'to-be' design.
- Based on business analysis activities, creating a number of user personas and user journeys.
- Wireframes and a requirements specification for development.
- Creating a requirements specification document.
- Creating a solution architecture and design documentation, to be updated as the project progresses.
- Creating test planning and execution documentation.

Solution Delivery

This focuses on the development of new applications using the selected Platform. We use a range of methodologies including our own proprietary methodology for implementation and delivery. The development team will determine the best approach for this on a case-case basis and will work collaboratively with your organisation to deliver a quality solution. To support go-live we can also provide communications, training, and business change support, where required.

Solution Testing

During any Deloitte development we will utilise proven testing techniques throughout the development phase, including Unit, System and Functional Testing. Our service helps buyers deliver high quality solutions with the selected Platform and typically includes:

- Development of testing strategy and testing approach.
- Designing and delivering functional and performance testing for services during design, build and release.

- Support and knowledge transfer to your organisation in order to complete System Integration Testing and User Acceptance Testing.

Ongoing and Post-Implementation Managed Support

We provide support for services that we have built and implemented.

The exact scope of support services is agreed on a case-by-case basis to match buyer needs, and can include:

- First line support for users.
- Second or third-line support for users.
- Ticket tracking and resolution.
