No refunds will be made, but the Ticket will be reinstated for use at a future Supply Chain Summit during the period for which the original Ticket was valid. In the event of non-attendance or cancellation after the 30-calendar-day cutoff, no refunds will be made without the above-referenced cancellation notice, and the Ticket will be forfeited
