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CIVIC Cookie Scanner CMP for GDPR Compliance - Service Definition

A cookie scanner is a tool (usually software or an online service) that scans a website to identify all the cookies it sets on visitors' browsers.

Key features:

- Cookie detection. Detects cookies used on a website (session cookies, tracking cookies, third-party cookies, etc.) and identifies their purpose (analytics, advertising, essential functionality)
- Compliance confirmation. Checks for compliance with privacy laws like GDPR, CCPA, or ePrivacy and offers advice to become compliant.
- Audit report. Generates reports listing every cookie dropped and the relevant details such as: cookie name and description, the product which drops the cookie and its purpose, cookie duration, cookie suggested category (optional or strictly necessary),
- Scheduling. Cookie scans can be scheduled to ensure compliance at all times. Audit report is received via email.
- Crawl and sitemap modes. You can either scan your website using the crawl mode, where the scanner will discover the linked pages of your website from the start page you will give it, or using the sitemap mode so the scanner will only scan the pages available in the sitemap you will provide.
- Scan behind Cookie Control option. If Cookie Control is active on your website, you can choose to run the scan before Cookie Control on, so the scanner will only discover the cookies dropped before consent is given, or behind Cookie Control and the scanner will report on all cookies dropped before or after consent is given.
- Integration with Cookie Control configuration. Automated HTML page generation for Cookie Policy, cookie categories and cookies automated transfer to the configuration. Templates for GTM and common deployment tools.
