D&B DATA CLOUD AI AND AGENTS - PRODUCT AND PRICING OVERVIEW

The Dun & Bradstreet Data Cloud provides access to over 620m global businesses with associated data such as business family trees, (hierarchy), financial risk, ultimate beneficial ownership data and much more. For detail as to the agents and Chat D&B please see the service definition.

The access to the D&B data using the D&B Agents or Chat D&B for Economic and Finance Economic and Financial Standing (EFS) checks and Financial, Viability Risk Assessments (FVRA) users will need to have a live contract for the required data blocks

The Blocks of attributes, can be also be accessed via an API, or via a batch method, or using one of the data sharing platforms such as Snowflake or Databricks. Customer data can be provided to D&B in bulk for matching and assigning the DUNS number, to allow for further enrichment for the many uses as above.

The data blocks available are defined in the service definition.

D&B DATA

This data helps you to create a single source of truth on suppliers, with access to financial data, scores and ratings for Economic Financial Standing checks (EFS) and Financial Viability Risk Assessments (FVRA)

Data for the ratios:

The D&B scores and ratings and raw financial data is available to support the checks. The D&B data also includes SME (Small, Medium Enterprise) and Voluntary Community and Enterprise (VCSE) flags that can be added to a supplier portfolio for reporting purposes, as well as the raw data and ratios used in calculating risk, as per the diagrams below updated in January 2026 -

Submit and receive files through multiple delivery methods, including the Web and STP, as well as customising the output to suit your needs.

Product pricing is shown below and is based upon:

1. Number of base records to match to and update/or to access.
2. The levels of data blocks – D&B Data Attributes are made available in blocks by relevant use case. E.G., Financial Risk.
3. The higher the level number the more data attributes will be provided, as per the Company Information detail below:

Company Information

Provides basic data about a company, including name and address, industry/business activity type, size, and country/region identification numbers.

- **Level1** - Basic information about a company primarily used to validate the Match found in Company Entity Resolution such as Business Name, Primary Address, Telephone, Web Address and Primary Industry Codes. This Level is required as it is the starting point for all data block licenses.
- **Level2** - Additional information on a company including Sales, Employees, Industry Codes, Mailing Address and other information.
- **Level3** - Information on a company's competition, editorial information and Assignment Model data.
- **Level4** - Country specific data elements that are considered of higher value and pertain to the organization. Currently specific to the Japanese market and includes primary supplier and customer names and D-U-N-S Numbers.
- **Advanced Geoposition** - More precise latitude and longitude for pinpointing where a business is located. This side block is available for the Public sector only.

4. Required access to the data per use case. E.G., if you are using the data for one use case such as supply chain needs but then wish to use the same data for a website to look-up and verify the business logging in – this will be classed as an identity verification use case. The use cases are 5 in total with relevant use case discount structures.
