Case study

For a rail organisation, **KPMG helped with transition from physical to digital training for 45,000 employees and 55,000 contractors**. Case study

We partnered with the **Centre for Digital Built Britain** to create a **Digital Twin (DT) Toolkit** to support organisation on their digital journey. The Toolkit comprises of a use case framework, case studies, business case template and roadmap; providing the reader with a basis for defining their use cases, and whether a DT can (and should) help achieve their business drivers. Working alongside a consortium of solution providers and consultants, our role in developing the Toolkit has enabled us to **leverage existing and new relationships to gain a broad and deep understanding of DTs, and shape the industry's digital transformation**.



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
