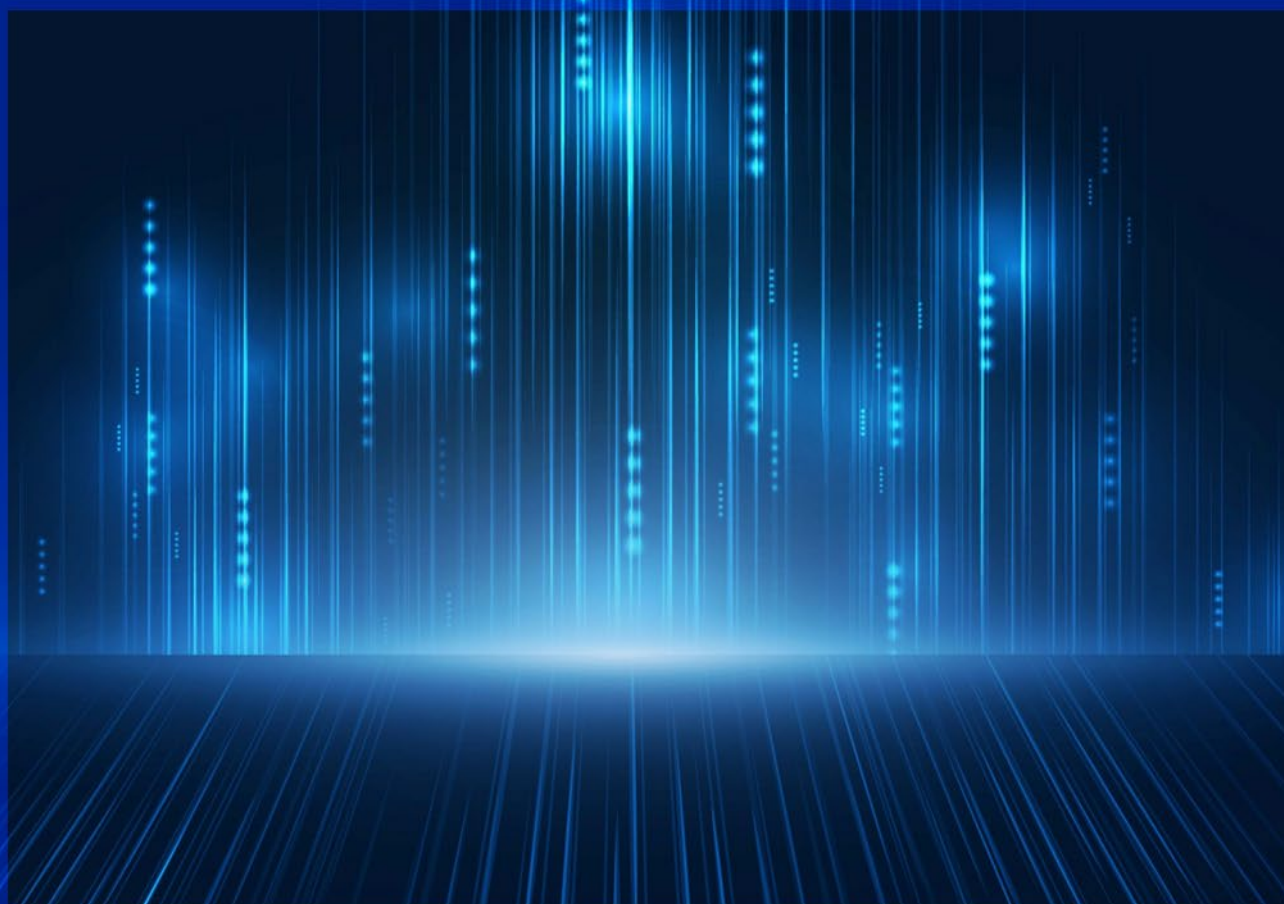

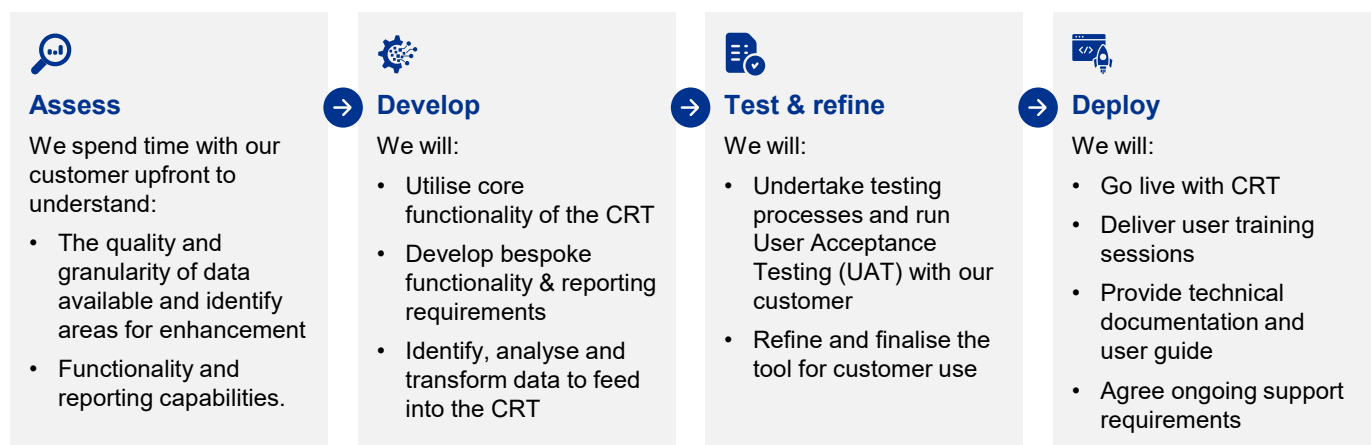

Our CRT is a suite of interactive dashboards to quickly understand and **assess the financial and operational performance** of complex contracts. This improves **cost transparency** and doubles as an easily accessible **repository for historic supplier data**. Good quality data is supplied on a regular basis throughout the life of a contract allowing analysis and challenge of cost and performance data, taking corrective action where necessary.

Our approach to delivering a CRT is split into 4 stages:



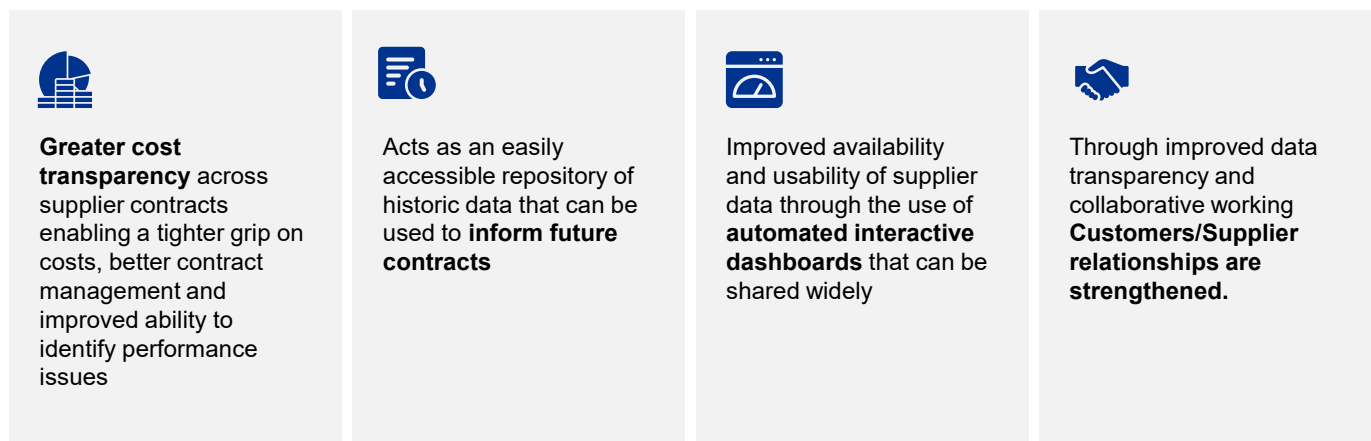
Common Issues with In-Contract Reporting?
