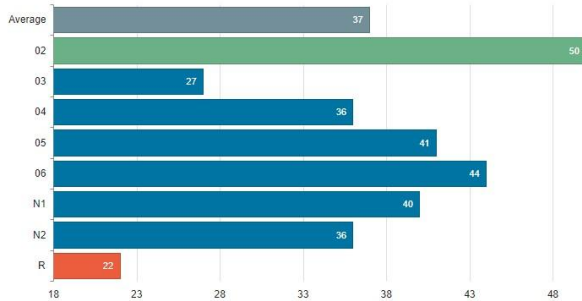

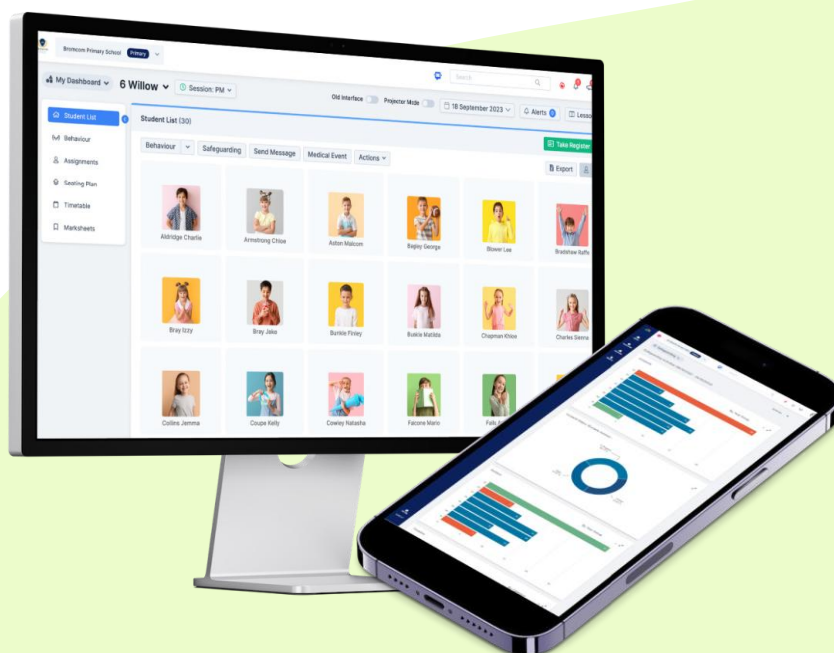

It brings staff, parents and pupils together in a single online platform and provides a powerful suite of administration, analysis and communication tools to support collaboration and improved outcomes.



In a special school, assessment tools need to be flexible and able to track small steps in progress. A fully configurable, built-in statement-level tracker enables you to customise goals for groups and individuals, so progress is monitored and analysed appropriately. Senior leaders can keep track of performance through analytics dashboards and automatic alerts. Teachers can also take registers, enter assessments, send messages and log behaviour incidents from the Class Dashboard.

Our MIS has a modular structure with stepped pricing, allowing your school to select a package that matches your needs and available resources. The **Standard package** includes the minimum requirements for a school to function effectively. The **Plus package** adds further modules and features for pupil and parent engagement, and the **One-Stop-Shop** offer combines Plus with our latest developments, including pupil safeguarding, parental communication and online payments for meals, clubs and trips. When combined with the additional Finance module, the solution brings key functions into one place, efficiently supporting the needs of a modern school.

Bromcom MIS One-Stop Shop

Our One-Stop-Shop package brings your data and core school processes into one integrated system, so information is entered once and then used consistently across reporting, analysis and day-to-day workflows. Consolidation also reduces reliance on expensive third-party bolt-ons, helping reduce overall cost.

With a single source of truth, secondary schools can analyse patterns across the full pupil journey. For example, leaders can explore how persistent absence is affecting attainment, or whether interventions such as a breakfast club are improving attendance outcomes.

Drill-down is available from summary and headline figures to help you investigate the detail behind the data. For example, when a behaviour total is displayed, you can drill down to the underlying pupils and staff. From there, selecting an individual pupil opens their behaviour dashboard and related events for more detailed review. This multi-layered approach is embedded throughout the MIS and aligns with expectations for a modern, cloud-based application.

Parents benefit from a single login to view all children across multiple schools, with each school able to control what information is shared. Real-time notifications can also be enabled, for example when behaviour events are recorded, ensuring families stay informed and engaged.

The Harris Federation has publicly reported savings of £2.8m over three years across 40–50 schools after switching to Bromcom. In the appendices, we have included examples of third-party products that schools have been able to retire by moving to a single, integrated platform.

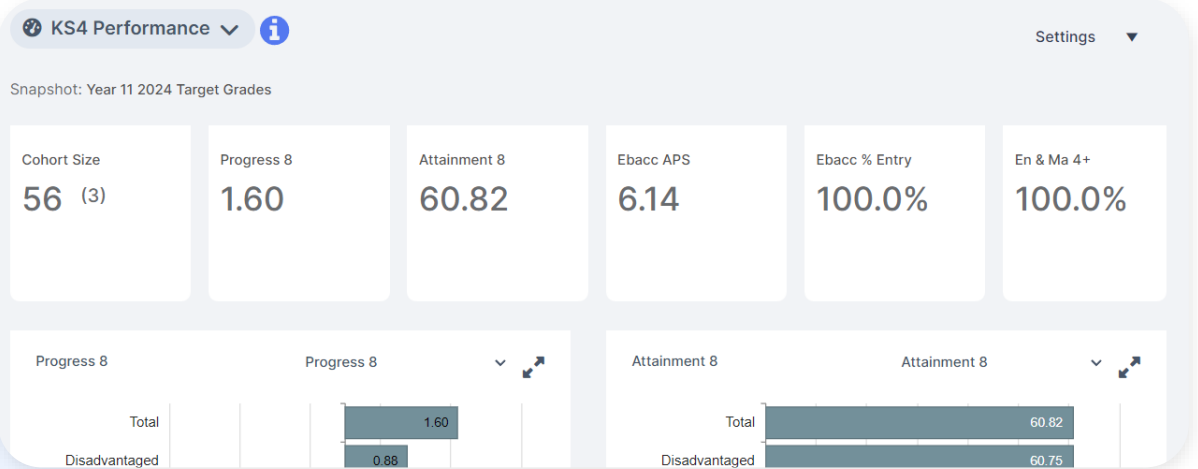

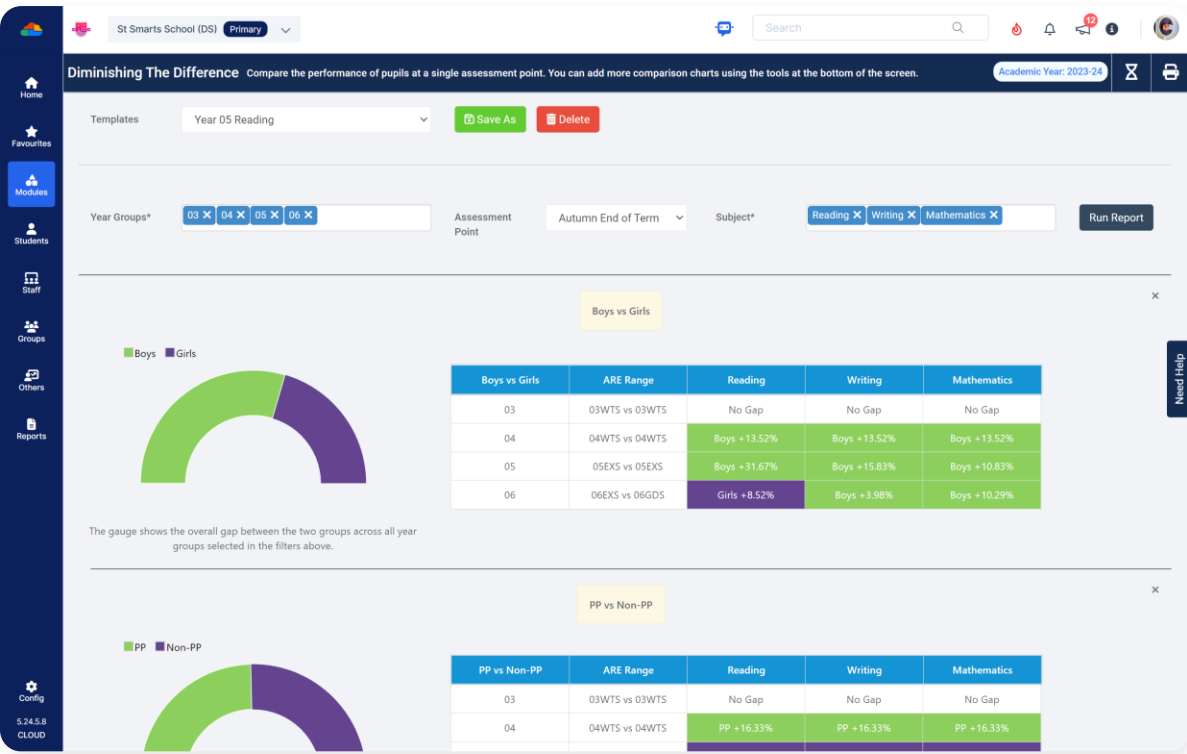

Built-in reports help you identify gaps and chart pupil journeys between assessment points. Whole-cohort and key group performance can be monitored throughout the year.



The Primary Tracker supports Summative Assessment, Formative Assessment, the Early Years Foundation Stage and Test Scores. The Primary Tracker Marksheets have been designed to be clear and uncluttered, giving teachers tools to reduce the time spent entering data, and giving them immediate feedback by using colour-coding to indicate the level each student is working at.

Prior Attainment Map Compare student performance between two different assessment points and quickly identify those students who have improved or regressed.

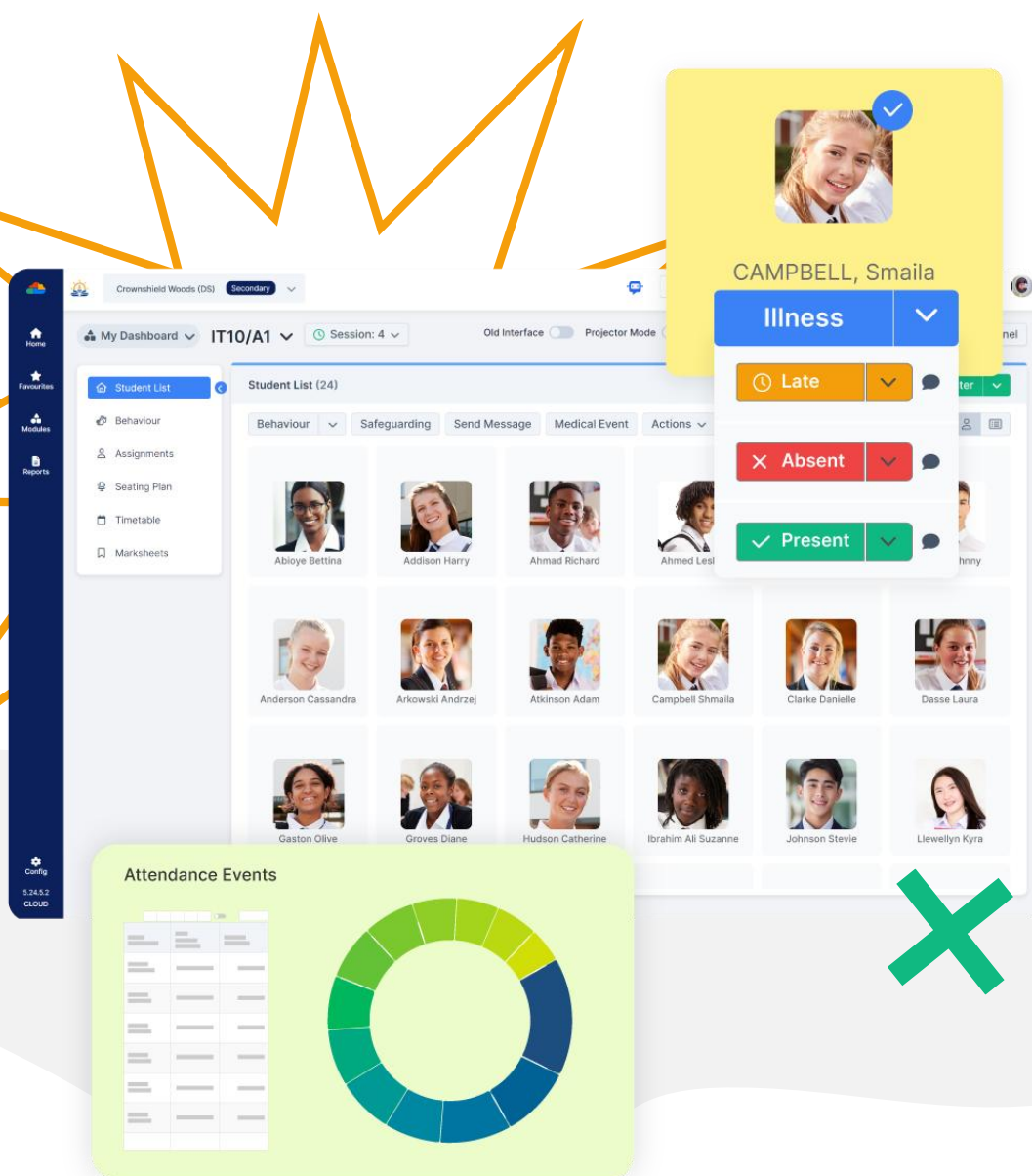

Much like with the Attendance module, an interactive dashboard helps you analyse behaviour patterns across your school, comparing events against rolling averages and previous years. You can compare cohorts using average points or events per pupil, explore trends over time, and drill down into individual pupil detail directly from charts and graphs.

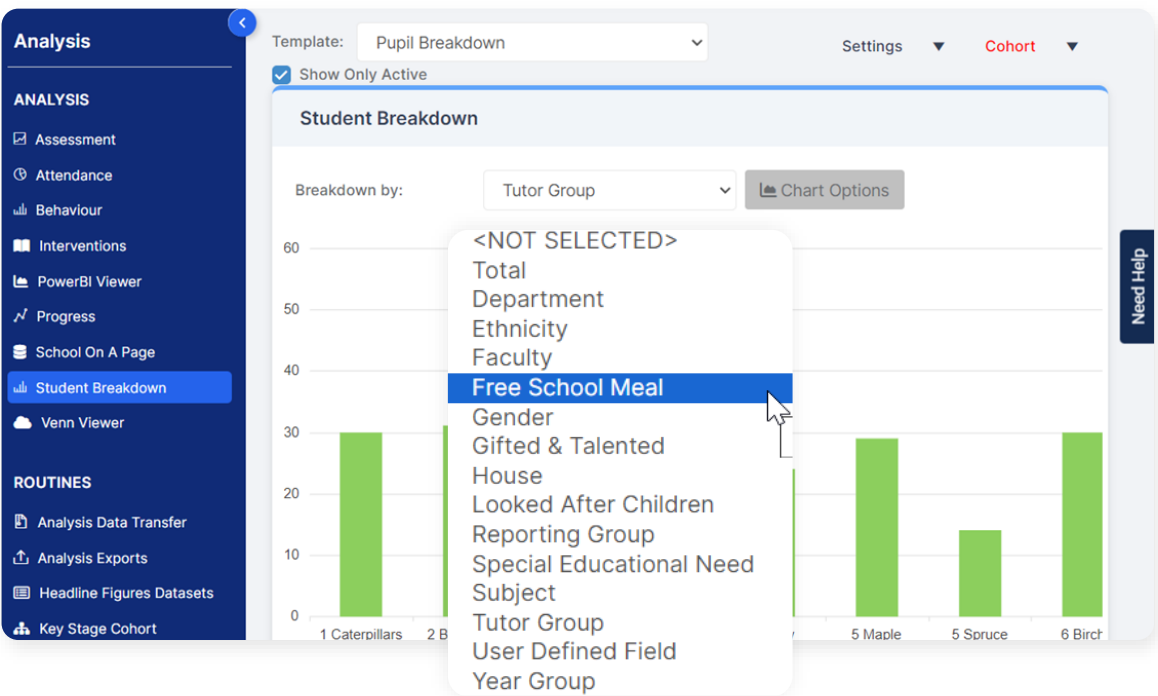
Reporting

Schools can attach Word templates and upload the finished documents directly to MCAS, our parent portal. A report scheduler automates recurring reports and routes them to the relevant staff member. Letters, certificates and reports can be issued electronically to pupils and parents via their portals, reducing your school's environmental impact and saving money on printing and postage.

Analysis Module

A graphical analysis and reporting module that helps monitor attainment and progress, attendance and behaviour. It includes residuals analysis, grade distribution and summary reporting, with extensive filtering options to support comparisons across pupil cohorts and vulnerable groups, including Pupil Premium, FSM and EAL.

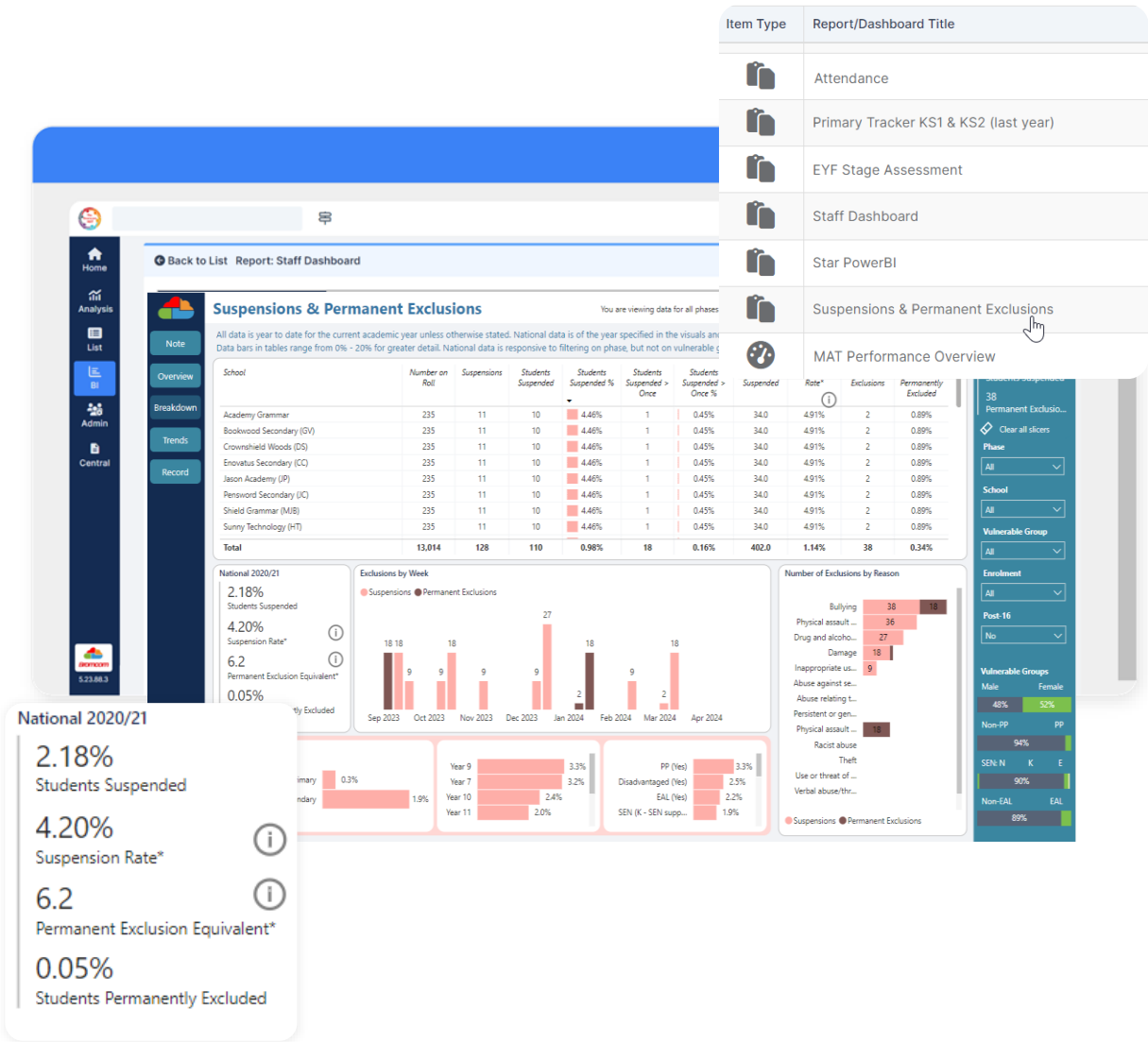
Power BI & Analytics

Bromcom Analytics is a set of reports and dashboards that provides an unparalleled view of school performance across individuals, cohorts and key contextual groups. It combines data on attendance, demographics and statutory assessment results.

This module also includes the Advanced Report Builder (ARB), a web-based reporting tool that supports grouping, conditional formatting and the creation of charts, tables and graphical indicators. You can also produce complex reports and integrate dashboards from commercial business intelligence tools such as Microsoft Power BI and Tableau. Live data feeds supply these dashboards with information from across the MIS, helping you measure the KPIs that matter to you.

Our unique link to Microsoft Power BI allows schools to create custom dashboards and present them within the MIS. Power BI can connect directly to Bromcom with no need to set up any additional reports or links.

Parental Engagement

The Parent Portal (MyChildAtSchool) provides real-time pupil information through a secure, easy-to-use interface, showing timetables, homework diaries, attendance, behaviour, assessments, clubs and trips. Dinners

Pupil and staff balances, meal choices and dietary requirements can be maintained in the integrated Dinner module. Meal registers, audits and catering returns can be produced quickly and accurately. Parents can also view balances and top them up via the Parent Portal.

Safeguarding

Safeguarding functions are provided within a highly secure area of the MIS to record information and actions for at-risk pupils and keep key stakeholders informed. The incident log captures a description, incident type and any other agencies involved, and includes a body map and attachments for adding supporting evidence to the record. Within the Safeguarding module, a time chart plots the occurrence of each incident type for easier review of patterns, and configurable alerts can notify relevant staff and authorised external stakeholders as soon as an incident is logged.

Staff Management

A full suite of staff management tools is provided in Bromcom MIS, including contract management, CPD, background checks and qualifications. It is suitable for use as your Single Central Record and can quickly generate an exportable document where required. School Workforce Returns can be produced, and the system links to both Bromcom Finance and third-party payroll systems.

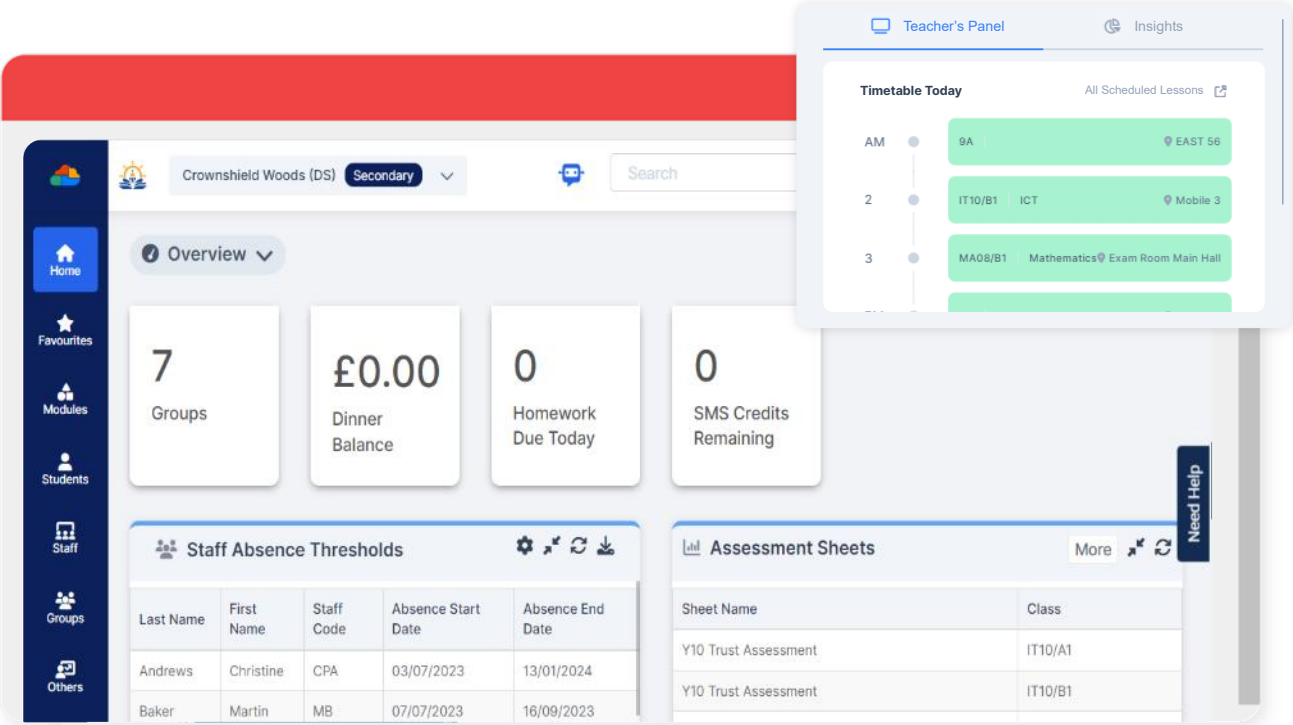

Class & Lesson Dashboards

Curriculum Management

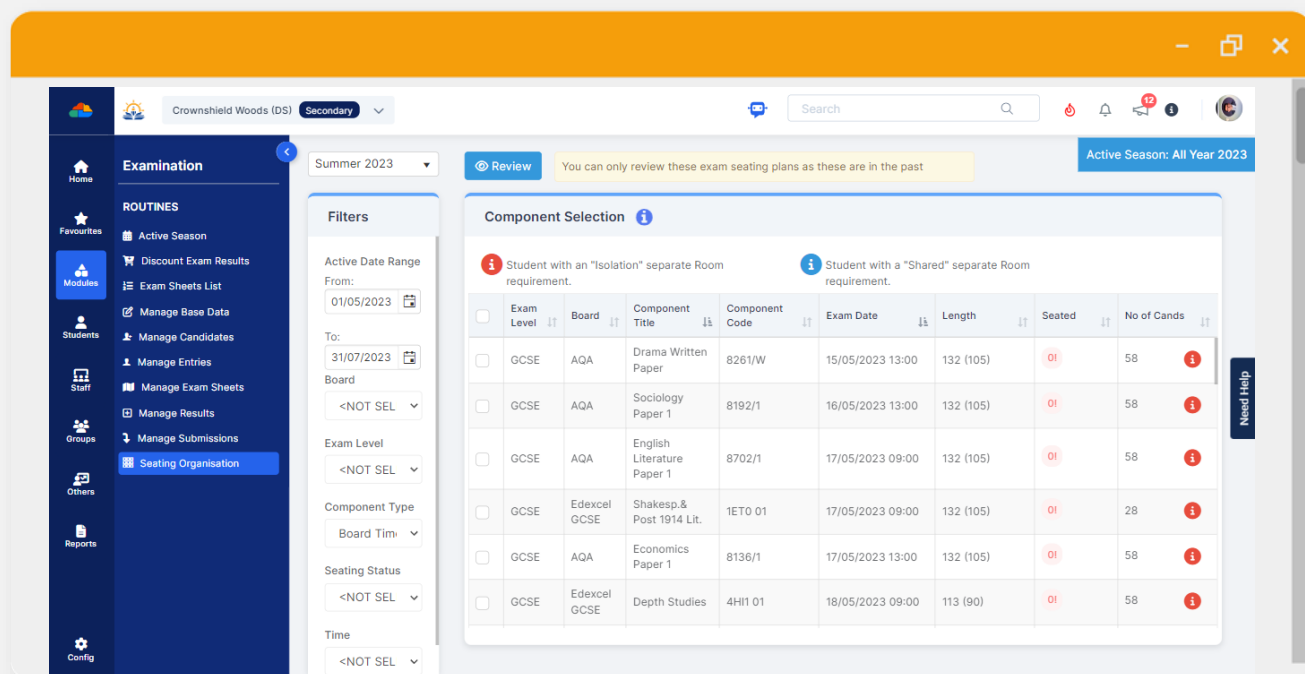

Exams

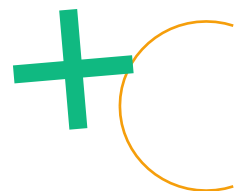
Statutory and internal examinations can be organised efficiently using our built-in Exams module. Base data can be imported from your examination boards and bulk assigned to the students undertaking exams within your school. Data can also be exported in the required format so entries can be submitted to the relevant exam boards. Multiple exam rooms can be managed, and specific exam considerations can be recorded against individual students. Seating plans can be generated for use by invigilators, and changes can be made easily to meet any seating requirements. Student-level exam timetables can be generated and shared via the student portal, so students can view examination information on their digital device.

On results day, you can import your data directly into Bromcom. Public or Private Cloud

By default, Bromcom MIS is delivered as a SaaS solution via a secure, multi-tenant, UK-hosted Microsoft Azure platform. This provides continuity of service, routine backups, managed updates, and strong cyber security, while benefiting from economies of scale to deliver high performance at a lower total cost.

Where required, Bromcom can also provide a Private Cloud option, delivering a dedicated cloud environment maintained specifically for the customer. This offers increased control but carries a price premium due to the additional infrastructure and replicated management services. Private Cloud infrastructure can be procured directly from Bromcom, or provided by the customer, with Bromcom hosting and managing the Bromcom applications, updates, and key database activities (including SQL installation and configuration). This option is available via the G-Cloud price list for organisations requiring a dedicated deployment model.

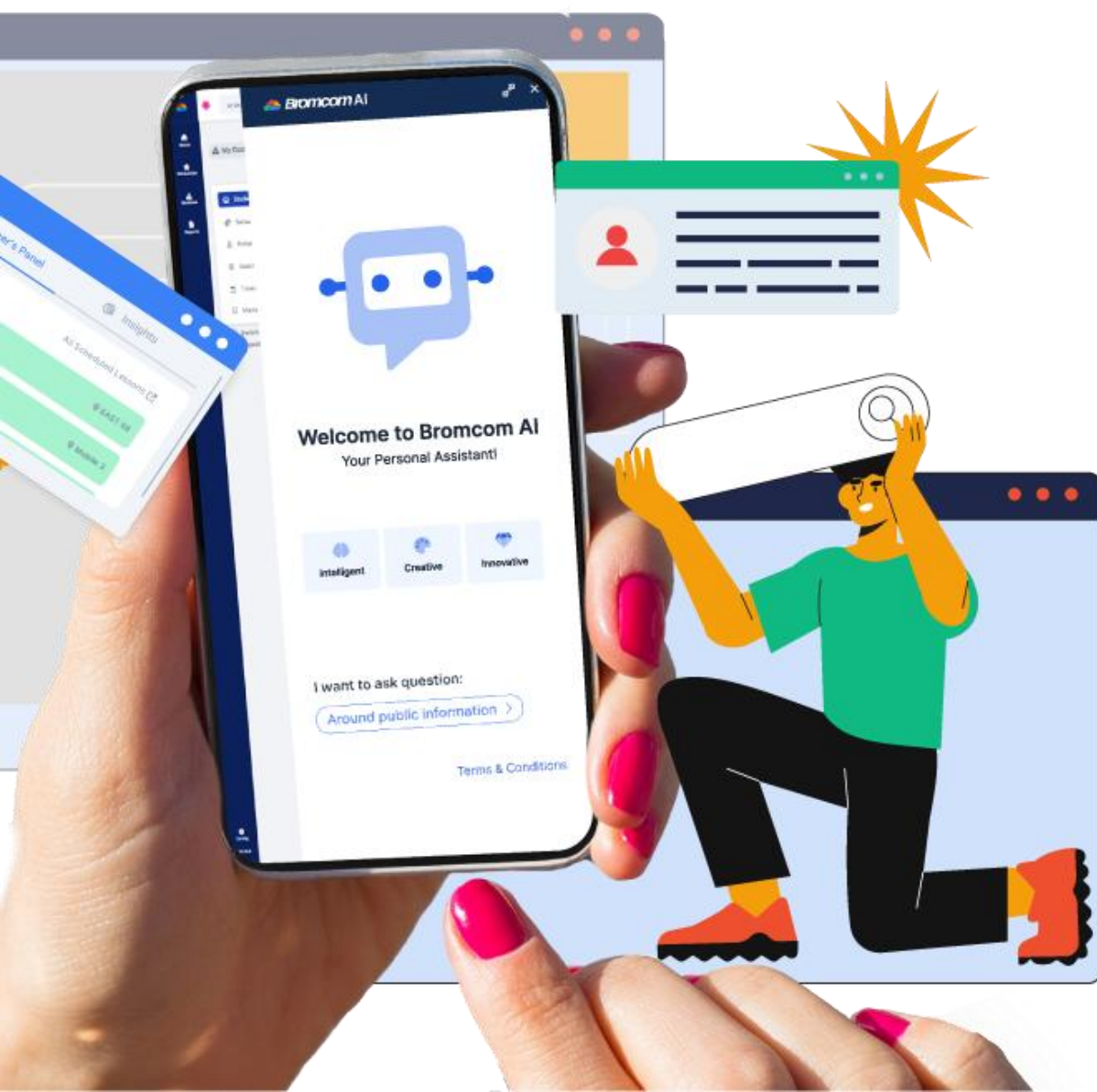
