Matrix Prism – Pricing

Overview

Matrix Prism is a modular, cloud-based Workforce Management platform designed to support public sector organisations in managing contingent, project-based, and non-permanent workforces.

Pricing is transparent, usage-based, and scalable, ensuring Contracting Authorities only pay for services they use, with no unnecessary licensing overheads. This approach supports predictable budgeting, reduces upfront barriers to adoption, and allows the service to scale naturally as workforce activity increases.

Core Platform Pricing (Workforce Management)

Prism Workforce Management System (WMS)

Matrix Prism's core Workforce Management service is charged on a transaction-based model.

- Price: 1% of spend processed through the platform.
- Charging basis: Applied only to transactions managed and approved through Prism.
- Implementation fee: £12,500 (one-off).

This pricing model:

- Ensures customers only pay when the platform is actively used.
 - Avoids high upfront or per-user licence fees.
 - Scales proportionally with workforce activity.
 - Supports transparency and value for money.
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Talent Pool Module Pricing

Prism Talent Pool Module

The Talent Pool module enables Contracting Authorities to attract, manage, match, and engage workers through bespoke internal and external talent pools.

The Talent Pool module is priced in line with the core Workforce Management service, using the same simple and scalable commercial model.

- Price: 1% of spend processed through the Talent Pool.
- Charging basis: Applied only to placements and engagements fulfilled via the Talent Pool.
- Implementation: Included within Prism platform implementation (no additional setup fee).

This ensures:

- Consistent pricing across Prism workforce services
- No additional licence or access fees
- Cost alignment with usage and value delivered

Module Pricing

Payroll Module

The Prism Payroll module provides a fully managed payroll service for contingent workers, supporting PAYE, limited company, sole trader, and umbrella engagement models.

- Price: 4% of the worker's Limited Taxable Salary (LTS)
- Charging basis: Percentage of payroll processed

This volume-based model ensures:

- Payroll costs scale proportionally with workforce size.
 - Pricing reflects the level of automation, compliance, and administrative support delivered.
 - No fixed licence fees regardless of workforce size.
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Statement of Work (SOW) Module

The Prism SOW module supports outcome-based, project-based engagements managed through Statements of Work.

- Price: 3% of the total value of each SOW processed.
- Charging basis: Applied to approved SOW value only.

This model:

- Avoids complex licensing or transaction fees.
- Aligns cost directly with delivered project value.
- Supports clear forecasting and commercial transparency.

Compliance Module – Prism eBulkPlus

Hosted Compliance (eBulkPlus) Module

The Prism eBulkPlus Compliance module enables high-volume DBS and screening activity through an integrated, hosted solution.

Eligibility requirements:

- Customer must be a DBS Registered Body (or become one).
- Minimum of 1,500 checks per year.

Fees:

- Implementation fee: £5,000 (one-off).
- Annual licence fee: £5,000.
- Administration fees: Volume-based (see table below).
- Government DBS fee: Charged at source (VAT exempt).
