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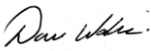

G-Cloud 15 – Pricing Document

The Engage service revolves around providing Suitably Qualified and Experienced Personnel (SQEP) to assist clients with the design, planning, implementation, and migration of cloud services. SQEP can be hired daily, with a minimum contract duration of one day.

Our pricing is based upon the Civil Service Grading Definitions given in the role descriptions in the G Cloud 15 application portal.

Discounts may be available through any of these commercial arrangements and will be considered on a case-by-case basis with buyers during the procurement process.

Caveat – International and Offshore Pricing Considerations

The day rates and pricing presented in the portal exclude all adjustments associated with offshore or internationally deployed consultants and excludes VAT and expenses.

Final rates may vary depending on contractual and jurisdictional factors including, but not limited to consultant location, high-risk region uplifts, local visa or immigration requirements, professional licensing obligations, regional taxation rules (including withholding tax), and any mandatory local certifications. Additional influences such as prevailing local market expectations, competitive norms, labour cost structures, and currency exposure may recalibrate the given rate. These elements can impact the financial model and must be confirmed prior to contract finalisation.

Furthermore, this pricing expressly excludes any costs related to international mobility, including travel, accommodation, daily allowances, hardship allowances, and assignment-related expenses, unless explicitly agreed otherwise. Insurance uplifts, local legal compliance, contract management requirements, and overheads associated with administering work abroad are also not included. The delivery model selected—remote, hybrid, expatriate deployment, or local partnering—will significantly influence cost and risk and will be priced accordingly once the project strategy is confirmed. All offshore and international pricing is therefore subject to detailed scoping, market validation, and final commercial agreement.
